When the *Code* requires a test that needs to be carried out for international movement or other designated purpose, the *Manual* should provide a recommended laboratory method.









Purpose of OIE Manuals



- > The Manual is the companion volume to the Code
 - Describe internationally agreed laboratory standard methods for disease diagnosis, and
 - Describe the requirements for the production/control of vaccines and other biological products (only for Terrestrial Manual)


Reports are circulated to Delegates, Focal Points and Organisations with cooperative agreement for their comments (each February and September)





Code Commission reviews comments, revises text and recirculates for further comment or proposes for adoption.

'Normally' two cycles to adoption is (2-4 years) Fast track can be 1 year

By consensus; in most cases


By vote (2/3 majority, quorum needed)

via Resolutions of the World Assembly of Delegates




