



Declaration of zones for disease control purposes

Divided into 3 zones

1.Control zone: 20 km

radius from IP

2.Protection zone: 50 km

radius from IP


3.Risk area: 100 km

radius from IP

Control measures	Control zone	Protection zone	Risk area			
Clinical monitoring	Monitor body temperature twice a day. If any abnormal symptoms has been detected, immediately notify DLD for further investigation.					
Vector control	Owners will be advised to protect equidae against vectors to reduce the likelihood of a susceptible animal becoming infected. Use an appropriate insecticides recommended by DLD on equidae or insect repellents. Additional vector control such as net / hood /fly sheet can also be used.					
Movement restriction	All movement of Equidae is prohibited until there is no case of AHS for at least 90 days					
Vaccination plan	Strategic v	accination	Prohibited of Vaccination			
Movement control (After vaccination)	All vaccinated equid are stabling in an insect prod					
Establishment of a containment zone	No reported case of AHS in Equidae for at least 90 days.


