


Important political documents

Self-assessment that provides practical guidance on how to implement rabies control activities




The SARE Assessment component






Example of incremental SARE increase






Estimated cost to eliminate dog mediated rabies by dog vaccination



Workplans that support National Strategies




The national workplan is the executable form of the National Strategic plans

Provide the granular detail for each of the broad objectives in the National Strategic Plan


