Immediate notifications reports for OIE-listed diseases should be submitted within 24 hours of disease confirmation. Quick notification following confirmation is essential to allow other countries to take any necessary preventive actions to avoid the spread of pathogens. The notification requirements are stipulated in Chapter 1.1. The *Terrestrial and Aquatic Animal Health Codes* stipulate in Chapter 1.1. that, in accordance with relevant provisions in the disease-specific chapters, **immediate notifications** should be submitted to the OIE within 24 hours of disease confirmation. **Follow-up reports** should be submitted on a weekly basis. The **Focal Point for Animal Disease Notification** is responsible for their submission.

The submission time recommended by the OIE for **six-month reports** (for OIE-listed terrestrial and aquatic animal diseases) is within one month after the end of the corresponding six months. The **Focal Point for Animal Disease Notification** is responsible for submitting these reports. The OIE recommends that the **National Focal Point on Wildlife** provide assistance to verify and complete the national data on wildlife diseases in the six-month report.

The **Annual report** contains information on the following: zoonoses in humans; animal populations; veterinary personnel; national reference laboratories; and vaccine production facilities. The submission time recommended by the OIE for this report is within 1.5 months after the end of the year. The **Focal Point for Animal Disease Notification** is responsible for this submission.
