Prevention activities to maintain FMD free status

Activity in 2021

- Improve the sensitivity of General Surveillance and targeted Surveillance for FMD
- Initial update on the possible risk pathway of FMD introduction

Key activities planned in 2022

- Finalization of New Guidelines for General Surveillance targeted Surveillance for FMD
- Socialization of new guidelines
- Training for District officers
- Integrating the new guidelines with capacity building program for Vet (FETPV)
- Continue to update the risk assessment on the possible incursion of FMD into Indonesia





Preparedness and Contingency Planning

Key changes/highlights in the FMD Preparedness and Contingency Planning in 2021

- Annual update on high-risk areas
- Improvement of laboratory capacity in testing
- Continued socialization activities for FMD preparedness

Key activities planned in 2022

- Increasing the awareness and communication activities for the field officer and farmers
 - ✓ Series of webinars
 - ✓ Other continuing education programs
 - √ Social media campaign
- Review and update the preparedness and contingency plan for FMD





Main challenges and recommended solution

- Implementation of serological-surveillance is restricted due to the pandemic
 - ✓ Continued to work with the local governments and regional disease investigation (lab) and optimize their support in the surveillance activities
 - ✓ Increasing general surveillance
- Incursion of ASF affecting some of the main focus on FMD program
 - ✓ Lesson learned from ASF (risk pathways and value chains) utilized to update the preparedness and contingency plan for FMD
