




- Department of Animal Health (DAH)

## Recent wildlife disease surveillance in Vietnam

- PREDICT (EPT-2) funded by USAID during 2010-2020
  - Targeted to: CoV, PmV, AIV, FlaviV, FiloV
- WildHealthNet funded by DTRA during 2018-2022
  - Targeted to: AIV, ASF, CoV, Rickettsia
  - Screening for sick/dead case(s) of wild animals

- ZODIAC (IAEA, OH approach including wildlife disease management)


































