

Malaysia: Basis for disease reporting


Animal Act 1953 Malaysia:

31. (1) Every owner or person in charge of any animal or bird infected with or reasonably suspected to be infected with disease shall immediately make a report to a veterinary authority...





Veterinary surgeons act 1974:




Guide to Professional **Conduct and Ethics** paragraph 9.1.7: Failure to report any notifiable disease, as defined under Section 31 of the Animals Act 1953 is an offense against the Act and a breach of professional ethics may be held liable under the law.

MALAYSIA: SOP RELATED TO ANIMAL DISEASE REPORTING

A total of 121 animal diseases (zoonotic and economic impact) are notifiable diseases listed under Animal Act 1953.

Disease investigation must be reported to MADIC within 24 hours: Epis 01, All positive diagnostic cases at the laboratory must be reported to MADIC within 24 hours.



SOP for Animal disease crisis management





