





25th Sub-Com meeting 1(5 December 2020)

- Issue of animal and animal product movement control in the sub-region
 - > Regional Animal Price Monitoring Study; Country level APM studies planned
- the importance of molecular diagnosis to identify the circulating FMDV strain and of vaccine matching study; and high proportion of uncharacterized FMDVs
 - Ongoing: Regional Expert Group for FMD/ Brainstorming breakout session
- FMD surveillance is not always sensitive in the sub-region and the lack of transparency further limits the quality of the shared information
 - ➤ LabNet/EpiNet meeting: Session on fit for purpose surveillance by Dr David Paton





EpiNet & LabNet Meetings 23 Feb 2021

- Characterization of FMD viruses from field outbreaks for tracing the source of the outbreaks, and share the genotyping results with the OIE SRR/OIE Ref Labs
 - ➤ Ongoing: Regional Expert Group for FMD
- organize regional studies to improve the knowledge on the gaps in the FMD reporting /national animal health information systems and approaches to improve
 - ➤ Study to understand National Animal Health Information System TL/ Philippines





National Coordinators Meeting (29 to 30 July 2021)

- to review and improve national vaccination protocol/ strategy in cognizance of the dynamics of circulating virus and epidemiology of FMD in the region and in the respective countries;
- to improve access to quality FMD vaccines compliant with the Chapter 3.1.8. of the OIE Terrestrial Manual of Diagnostic Tests and Vaccines for Terrestrial Animals, through (i) advocacy to policy makers, (ii) use of national and ASEAN registration systems and (iii) development /review of fit-for-purpose procurement process.
- To develop Guidelines for national procurement of good quality veterinary vaccines.
 - Guideline being developed by WOAH





26th SEACFMD Sub-Commission Meeting (16 to 18 March 2022)

- to conduct capacity building for human and technical resources such as advance epidemiology and data analysis, use on PCR for routine diagnosis, etc;
 - Ongoing
- Enhance communication by digitization of FMD communication materials and development of SEACFMD Portal and dashboard.
 - Communication materials digitized;
 - ➤ SEACFMD Portal launched during 25th NC Meeting in October 2022





26th SEACFMD Sub-Commission Meeting (16 to 18 March 2022)

• To work on procedures to validate and declare freedom from Asia 1 serotype from the SEACFMD region.

≻Ongoing

- to strengthen epidemiological investigation and management of FMD outbreaks with collection of samples and laboratory diagnosis including virus characterization and ensure closure of outbreak
 - ➤ Brainstorming session on day 3 of the 25th NC Meeting





Special Meeting of the SEACFMD National Coordinators focused on FMD Preparedness and Response (12 June 2022)

Number of recommendations to enhance FMD preparedness and Response

- FMD preparedness Review Legislative framework, Contingency Plan, Surveillance System, HR Capacity, Laboratory diagnostic capacity, Financing etc.
- Enhance early warning risk assessment, targeted surveillance, epidemiological intelligence etc.
- Rapid detection refresher course for animal health staff, awareness to animal owners, surveillance, develop laboratory diagnostic capacity.
- Enhance Rapid response review and test contingency plan, improve Incident Command System, develop emergency vaccination plan.
 - WOAH SRRSEA shared relevant resources to the Indonesia and other MCs at the risk of FMD incursion.

25th SEACFMD National Coordinators Meeting, Bali Indonesia (3 – 5 Oct 2022)

- to enhance timely information sharing through WAHIS and ARAHIS, especially on FMD virus circulation that could assist the entire region in decisions on risk mitigation and, consequently, progress along the FMD Roadmap for the region;
- Number of recommendations to FMD Preparedness and response including
 - Early Warning/ Prediction;
 - Prevention;
 - Rapid detection;
 - Rapid response
 - Brainstorming session during the Breakout session





25th SEACFMD National Coordinators Meeting, Bali Indonesia (3 – 5 Oct 2022)

- to conduct immediate outbreak investigation and sampling for FMD to increase the number of outbreaks are serotyped by ensuring sufficient quantity and quality of sample collection, submission to the National laboratories in a timely manner;
- to immediately report any FMD outbreaks and continue to regularly share information on FMD virus circulation (different FMDV serotypes and strains) that could assist the entire region in decisions on risk mitigation and, consequently, progress along the FMD Roadmap for the region;
- to explore approaches to enhance timely reporting and to conduct detailed outbreak investigations of reported outbreaks (ARAHIS, WAHIS and National Information System);
 - > Brainstorming session during the Breakout session
