Control Measures - Vaccination

- Vaccine types used: Homologous, attenuated
- Source of vaccine: Turkiye, LSD-NDOLL
- Total doses imported : 60,525 doses
- Any local production of LSD vaccine : No
- Animal types vaccinated: Cattle and buffalo for both dairy and beef in total of 91,124 heads
- Vaccination (coverage, any outbreak in vaccinated animals, any adverse reaction): 45% vaccination coverage, no outbreak in vaccinated animals, neethling response was observed (minimal)



Control Measures – Others

- Surveillance
 - ✓ Clinical surveillance conducted
- Biosecurity
 - ✓ Thorough disinfection of personnel protective equipment (PPE), vehicles & vaccination tools
- Movement control
 - ✓ Revision on import protocols of infected countries
 - ✓ Strengthen control of illegal animal movement at international border with other agencies
 - ✓ Impose vaccination of susceptible animals before movement (inter-state, inter-districts)
- Stamping out
 - ✓ Strengthen culling effectiveness by improving compensation rate
- Legislation
 - ✓ Animal Act 1953 (rev. 2013) under Section 18 to 36. LSD is one of 121 notifiable diseases.
- Awareness and risk communication
 - ✓ Continuous and comprehensive public awareness campaign conducted seminar, dissemination of information through social media such as FB, Instagram, poster, banner, pamphlets and direct communication to the farmers
 - ✓ Increase knowledge and awareness among stakeholder (traders and farmers) and extension staffs on economic impact of LSD



Main challenges and recommended solution

- Animal farming system more than 85% is smallholder / backyard
- Illegal animal movement among traders
- Low cooperation among farmers in culling infected animals and vaccinating their animals (due to neethling response that will lower the price of animal & their perception that single vaccination is enough)
- Lack of awareness & knowledge on economic impact of LSD among farmers & extension staffs
- Short lifespan of vaccine once opened
