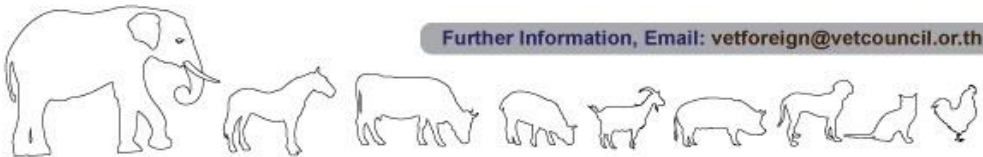

# Terms of Reference for the ASEAN Veterinary Statutory Body Network, **AVSBN**



## Objectives:

- To create a regional forum for the National VSBs of ASEAN Member States and equivalent authority (where a National VSB does not exist) for the purpose of sharing information, knowledge and experiences related to the policies, authority and functions of the National VSBs
- To promote collaboration between ASEAN Member States in supporting the development/establishment of fully functioning National VSBs in Member States currently without VSBs or where VSBs are being developed;

## **Terms of Reference for the ASEAN Veterinary Statutory Body Network, AVSBN**

- To mutually support the implementation of international standards related to VSB in ensuring the capacity of National VSBs in promoting good veterinary governance within a country
- To harmonise the National VSB best practices and operational guidelines, thereby facilitating transboundary mobility of veterinarians/ veterinary paraprofessionals between ASEAN Member States without prejudice to personalities, religious beliefs, socio-cultural and even political diversities
