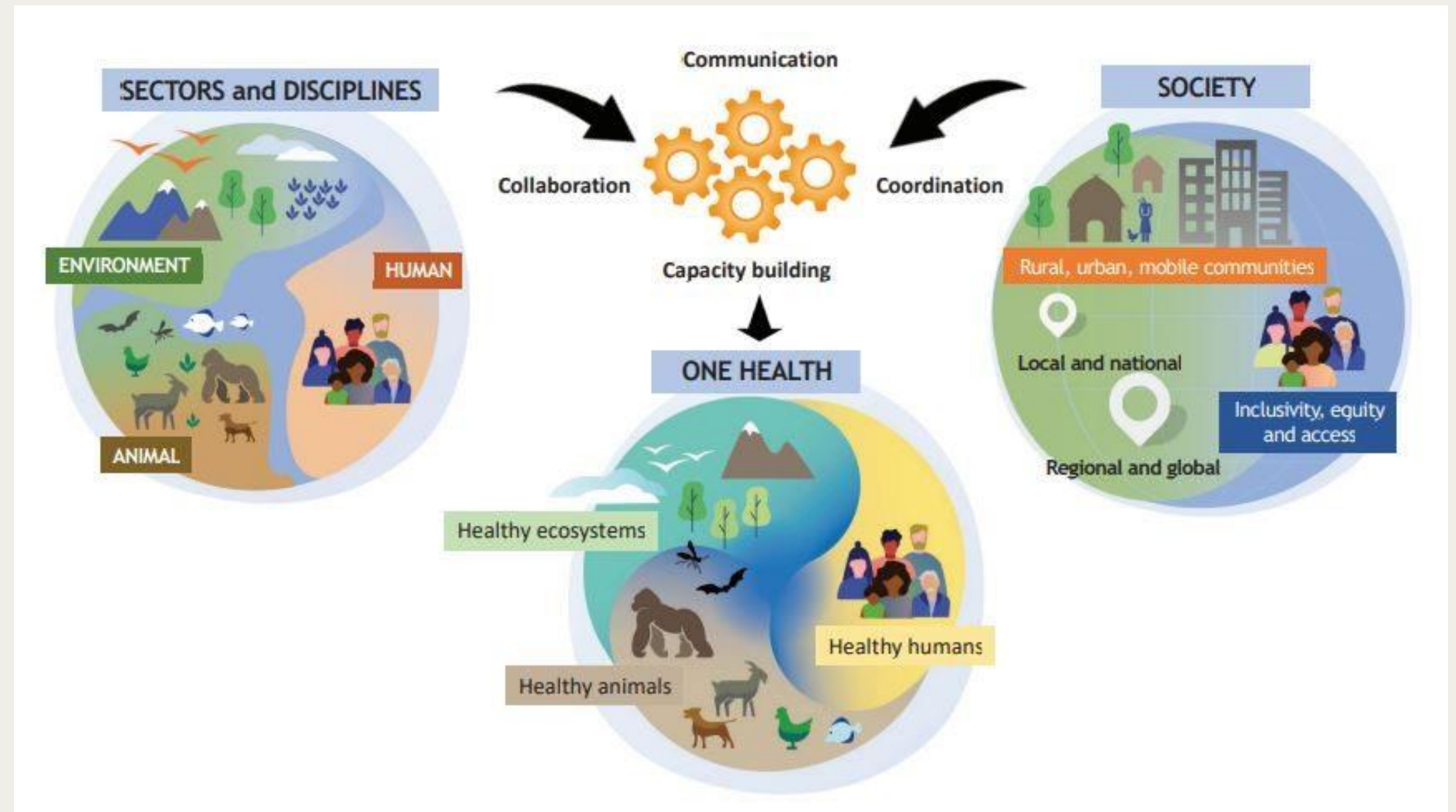

One Health Global Architecture

- **One Health** was already on the international agenda, but COVID-19 reiterated its importance:
 - Emphasis on **disease spill over from animals to people** that results in pandemic
 - Links between **deforestation, climate change, biodiversity loss** and disease emergence
 - Increasing number of **multidimensional health, animal, water, energy, food systems transformation, food security, & pollution** necessitate One Health collaboration, coordination, communication and capacity building
 - Increasing **political commitment and international support** for One Health
- November 2020: One Health High Level Expert Panel (OHHLEP)
- February 2021 - 27th Tripartite Annual Executive Meeting: agreement to jointly develop a strategy and **action plan to prevent future zoonotic pandemics** through the One Health approach

One Health Definition



The Quadripartite Collaboration

March 2022: unique opportunity for **FAO, UNEP, WHO** and **WOAH (formerly OIE)** to stand **together as a global coalition** to jointly drive change and achieve the transformations desired: the Quadripartite Collaboration



For a world better able to **prevent, predict, detect, and respond** to health threats and improve the health of humans, animals, plants, and the environment while contributing to sustainable development.

The One Health Joint Plan of Action – OH JPA

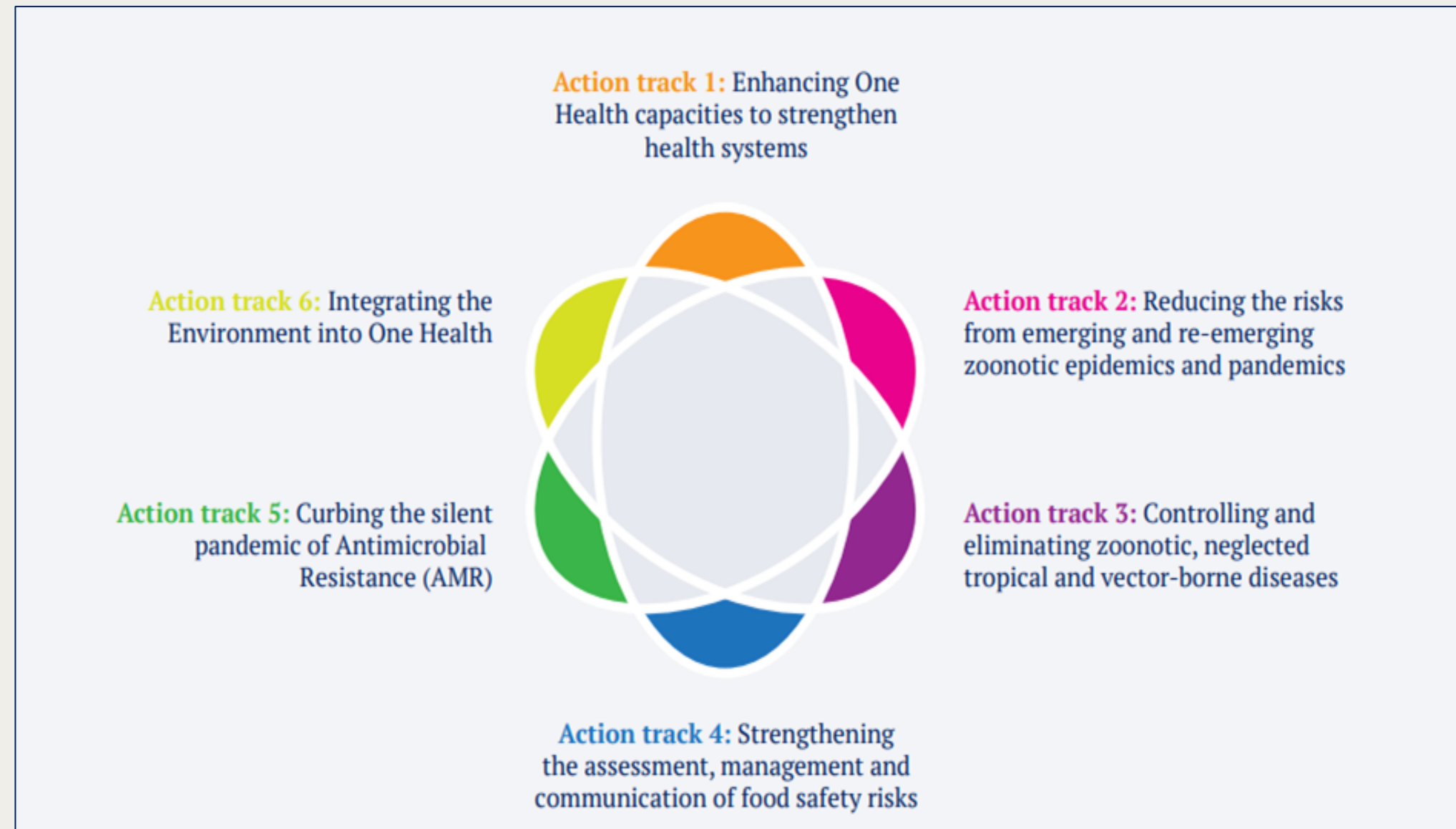


One Health Joint Plan of Action, 2022-2026

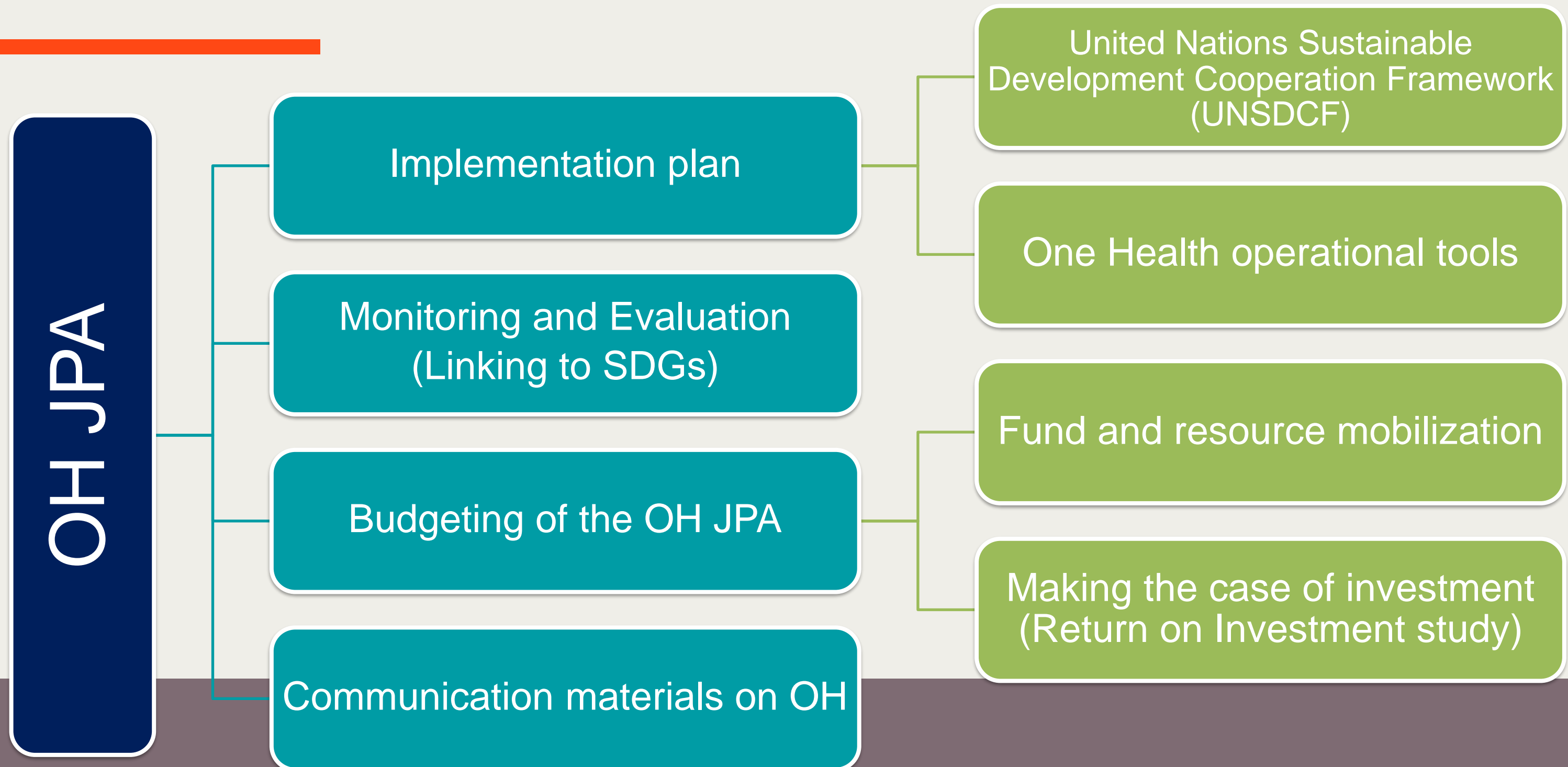
This Plan is global, comprehensive, and inclusive. It aims to mainstream and operationalize One Health at global, regional, and national levels; support countries in establishing and achieving national targets and priorities for interventions; mobilize investment; promote a whole-of-society approach and enable collaboration, learning, and exchange across regions, countries, and sectors.

The OH JPA was officially launched in October 2022.

The OH JPA Action Tracks



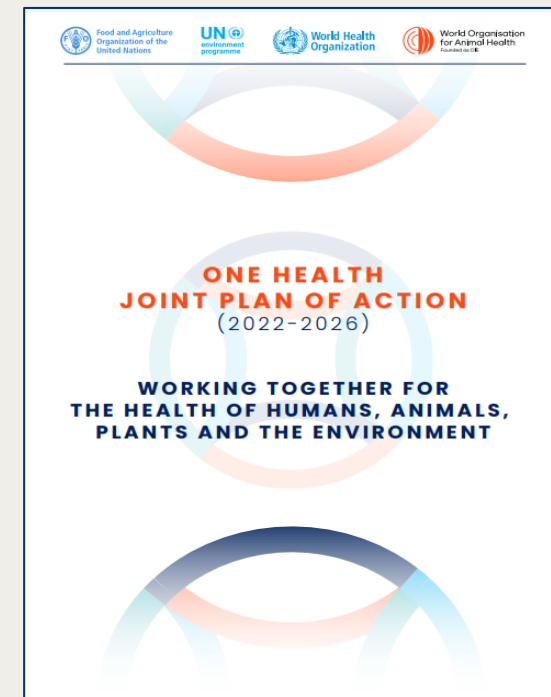
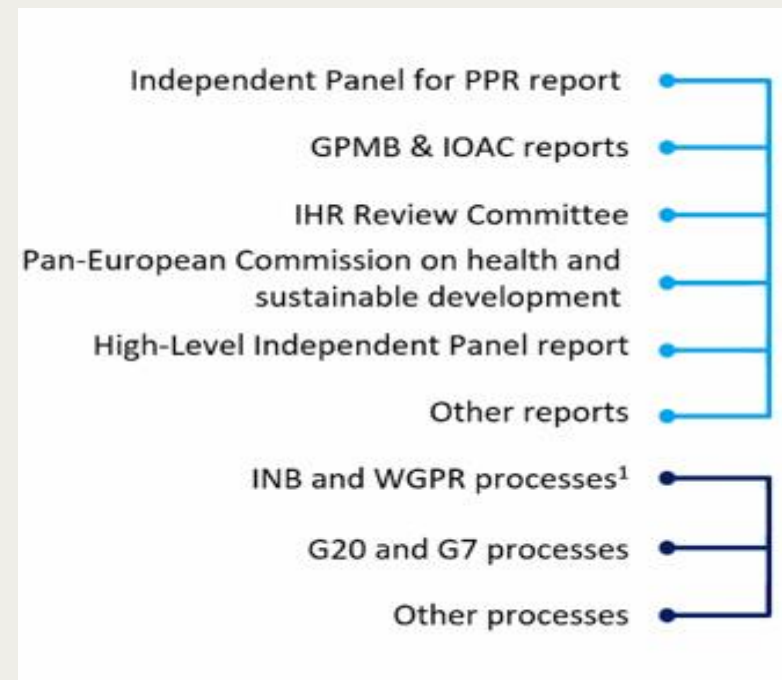
The next steps of the OH JPA

Collective advocacy for needed investments



World Bank-WHO identified that the **Global Architecture for Public Health Emergency Preparedness** requires

approx. 30 billion \$ annually

10 billion \$ should also be needed for prevention using a One Health approach

- Need for investment is a shared responsibility
- Will require all forms of financing, from multilateral development banks, international financial institutions, domestic resources & private sector
- To better connect funding and broader finance for county-level investments, recommend the One Health approach (the whole of government & society)
- *One Health Joint Plan of Action* provides an investment framework for action
