1. Collaboration with the AVSBN to develop the SEA veterinary school accreditation standards to be used as objective criteria for intra-ASEAN mobility of veterinarians
1. Collaboration among the members of SEAVSA and SEAOHUN to address One Health issues to support global One Health agenda
1. Exchange of academicians, researchers, administrative staff and students
1. Promotion of collaborative research, symposia, training and other activities of mutual interest
