- 1. Collaboration with the AVSBN to develop the SEA veterinary school accreditation standards to be used as objective criteria for intra-ASEAN mobility of veterinarians
- 1. Collaboration among the members of SEAVSA and SEAOHUN to address One Health issues to support global One Health agenda
- 1. Exchange of academicians, researchers, administrative staff and students
