## Veterinary Public Health Unit

Livestock feed (poultry) is monitored under the Quality Control and Hygiene Monitoring Program for:

- 1. Nutrition and Toxicology;
- 2. Drug Residue (Chloramphenicol); and
- 3. Animal protein contamination.

### Veterinary Laboratory Services Unit

As a National Veterinary Laboratory providing analysis to support programs under the Livestock Industry and Veterinary Services Division.



## Overview of Feed Safety Monitoring and Control in Brunei Darussalam

#### Feed Regulation

- Currently, there is no sole Animal Feed Regulation established for the country.
- However, under the Animal (Farm Licensing) Regulations, there is a condition of livestock product (raw chicken/beef/table eggs) to be within regulatory limits/MRL for Veterinary Drugs.
- Current veterinary condition for approved importation of plant-based animal feed is no contents of MBM and fishmeal only.

#### **Laboratory Involvement**

- Veterinary Laboratory Services Unit has the capacity to perform analysis for feed including:
  - i. Determination of Nutritional value;
  - ii. Detection of Toxins Aflatoxins;
  - iii. Drug Residue Chloramphenicol;
  - iv. Gross Calorific Values; and
  - v. Animal species identification for detection of animal protein.
- The laboratory has recently acquired new machineries: LC-MS/MS and HPLC to expand testing to multi-drug and multi-mycotoxins detection for animal feed, and currently developing the test methods.



## Overview of Animal Feed Industry in Brunei Darussalam

#### Local Feed Mills

- Currently, there is only 2 main livestock feedmills in Brunei Darussalam.
- Majority of livestock feed is imported, including importation of raw materials for the milling which are sourced from other countries including Malaysia, Thailand, Argentina, USA, India and many more.



## Challenges and Way Forward

#### Challenges

- Establishing Animal Feed Regulation and developing baselines for residues as standards in animal feed.
- Developing test methods and validation on the determination of pesticides suited for animal feed safety requirement in Brunei Darussalam.
