Communication in the region


- 5.16 billion people were active internet users as of January 2023, encompassing 64.4 percent of the global population.
- Global number of unique smartphone users was an estimated 5.44 billion.

- A global population of 8.01 billion people means smartphone penetration rate is 68 percent.
- Number of active social media users: 4.75 billion, or 59.4 percent of the global population.










Share your efforts




