
Global situation of ASF outbreak since 2007







>5 years of AFSV spread in Asia-Pacific region













ONCE PRESENT, ASF PERSISTS FOR A LONG TIME

ENDEMIC ASF DETECTION IS NOT LIKE EPIDEMIC ASF

- SUBCLINICAL SIGNS OR ABSENT
- ➤INCREASED SEROPREVALENCE AND DECREASED PCR-PREVALENCE
- >INCREASED RISK OF CARRIERS
