# Follow-up report


**Type:** AQUATIC

**Disease:** Infectious hypodermal and haematopoietic necrosis virus (Inf. with)

**Causal agent:** Hypodermal and haematopoietic necrosis virus

**Reason:** First occurrence in the country

**The event occurs in:** The country/territory

 Create a follow-up report with no evolution

 Create follow-up report n. 1

- “resolved event” VS “event declared stable”
- End date of an event
- Update an on-going event





# Six monthly reports

- Work arounds ( eg refresh, login log out, regularly save)
- Species first
- Fill gaps in reporting
- New module coming soon

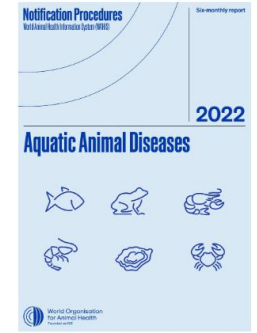
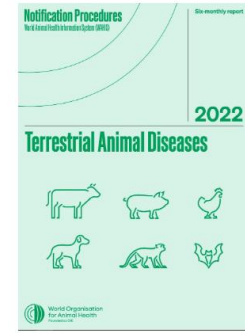

<b>Disease present</b>	The disease is present with clinical signs in the whole country (in domestic species or wildlife).
<b>Disease limited to one or more zones</b>	The disease is present with clinical signs and limited to one or more zones/compartments (in domestic species or wildlife).

**Occurrence codes indicating the presence of the infection or infestation in domestic species or in wildlife without clinical signs**

<b>Infection/infestation</b>	Confirmed infestation or infection using diagnostic tests, but no clinical signs observed (in domestic species or wildlife).
<b>Infection/infestation limited to one or more zones</b>	Confirmed infestation or infection using diagnostic tests, but no clinical signs observed and limited to one or more zones/compartments (in domestic species or wildlife).

**Occurrence codes indicating disease, infection or infestation absence in domestic species or in wildlife**

<b>Disease absent</b>	<p>The disease was absent in the country during the reporting period (in domestic species or wildlife). In this case, indicate the date of last occurrence of the disease if known. The date of last occurrence is the date when the disease, infection or infestation was last declared absent by the Veterinary Authority.</p> <p><b>Important:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ If the full date is unknown, please select the last day of the known month or year. For example, if your records show 04/2010, the date to be entered is 30/04/2010. If only the year is available (e.g. 2010), the date to be entered is 31/12/2010.</li> <li>▪ Tick the box "Date unknown" if the date of last occurrence is not available.</li> <li>▪ In the WAHIS online notification application, if the disease was present previously and is now reported as absent, the system will display the date of last occurrence automatically in the on-going report.</li> <li>▪ If the disease was reported by immediate notification/follow-up report and the event was closed, the WAHIS online notification application will automatically prefill this field with the accurate date. However, it is always possible to manually indicate in the system the date from which the disease is considered absent even though it has not been notified as an exceptional event.</li> </ul>
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<b>Disease suspected</b>	The presence of the disease was suspected but not confirmed (in domestic species or wildlife).
<b>Disease suspected but not confirmed and limited to one or more zones</b>	The presence of the disease was suspected but not confirmed and limited to one or more zones/compartments (in domestic species or wildlife).
<b>No information</b>	No information is available regarding the presence or the absence of this disease during the reporting period (in domestic species or wildlife).

**Disease, infection or infestation never reported (in both domestic species and wildlife)**

<b>Never reported</b>	<p>The disease has never been reported (historically absent) for the whole country in either domestic species or wildlife.</p> <p><b>Important:</b> once a disease has been reported in the country, the occurrence code "Never reported" can no longer be applied to either domestic species or wildlife.</p>

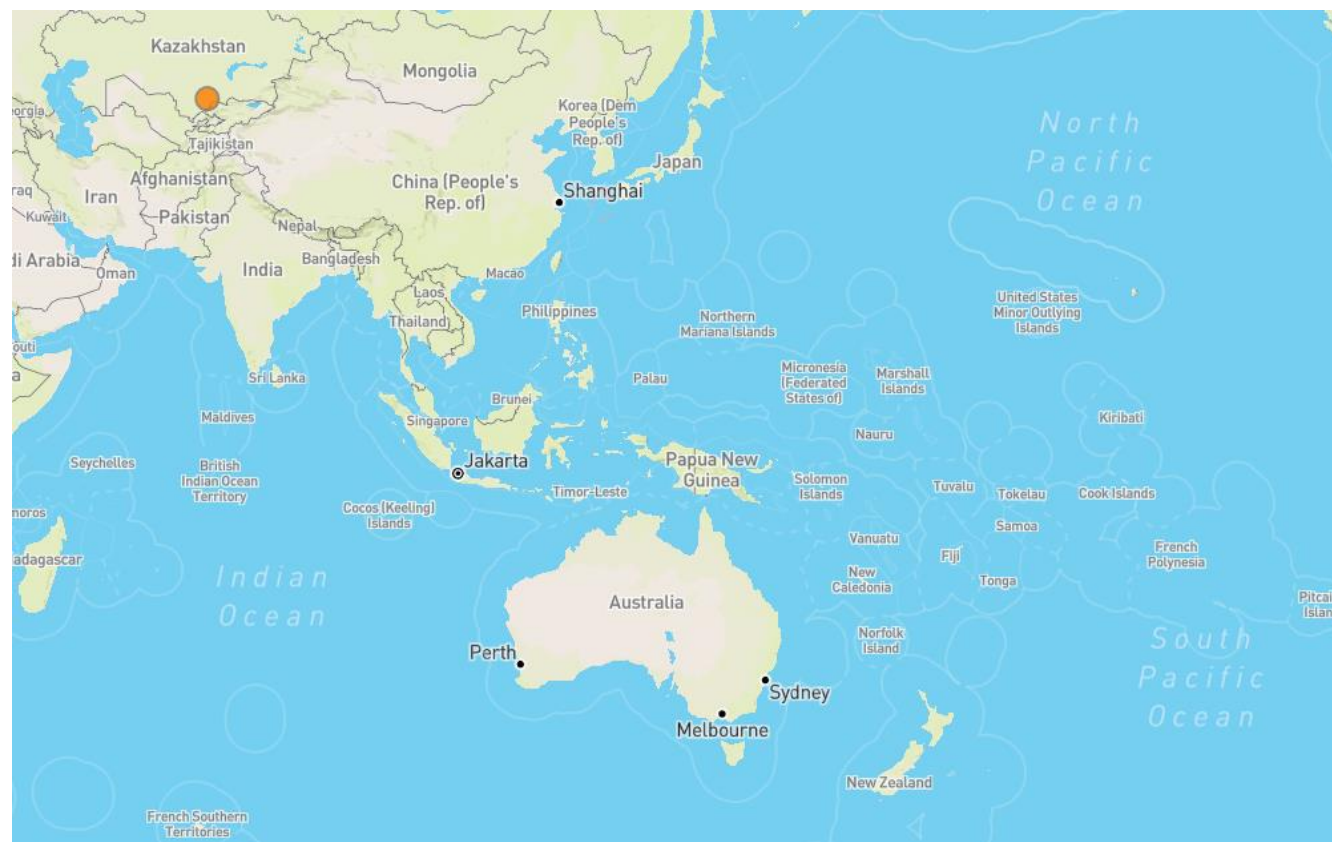

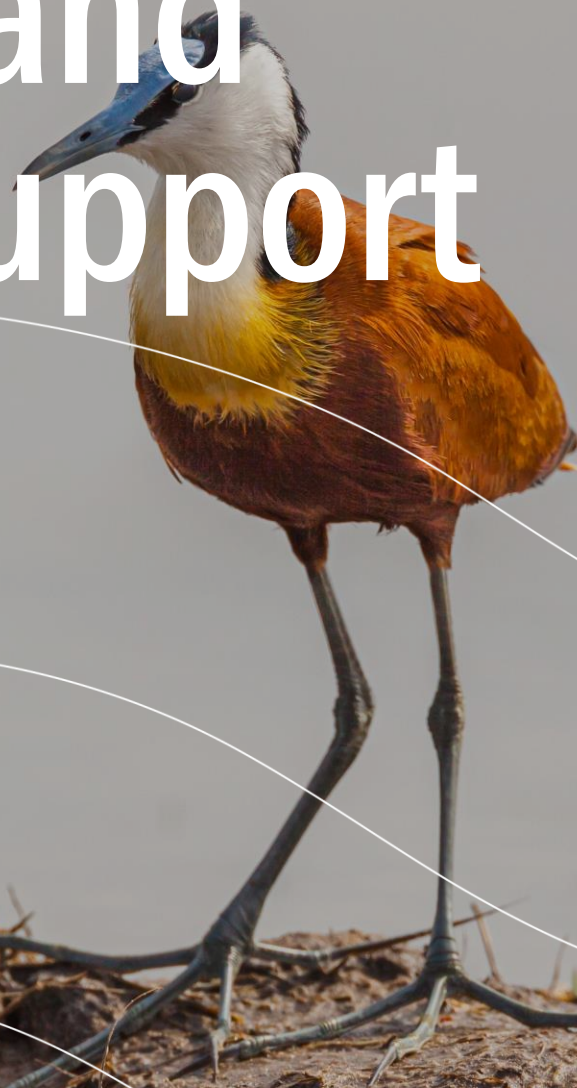
