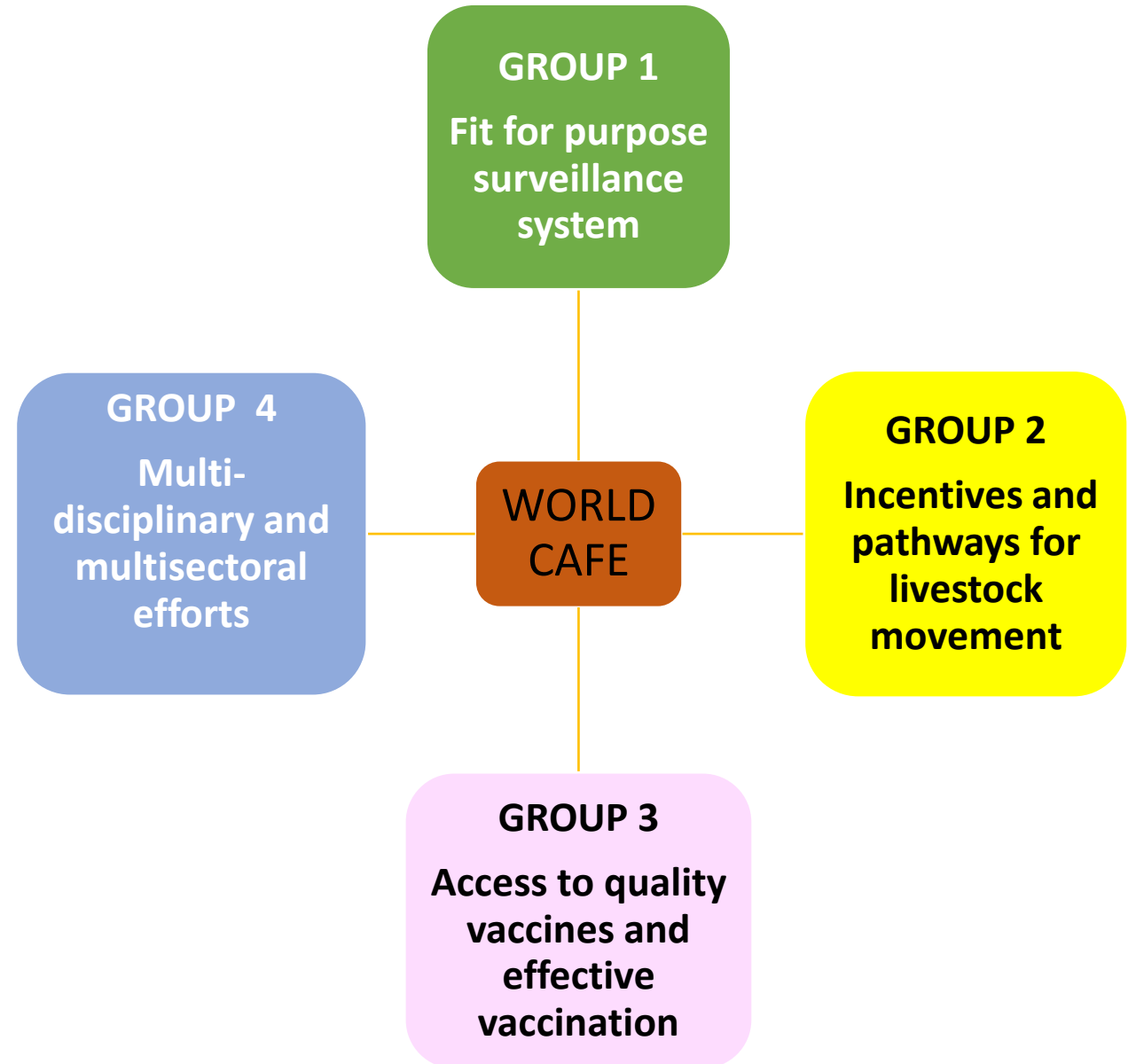
CAFÉ BOOTH

- Add missing points using post it notes



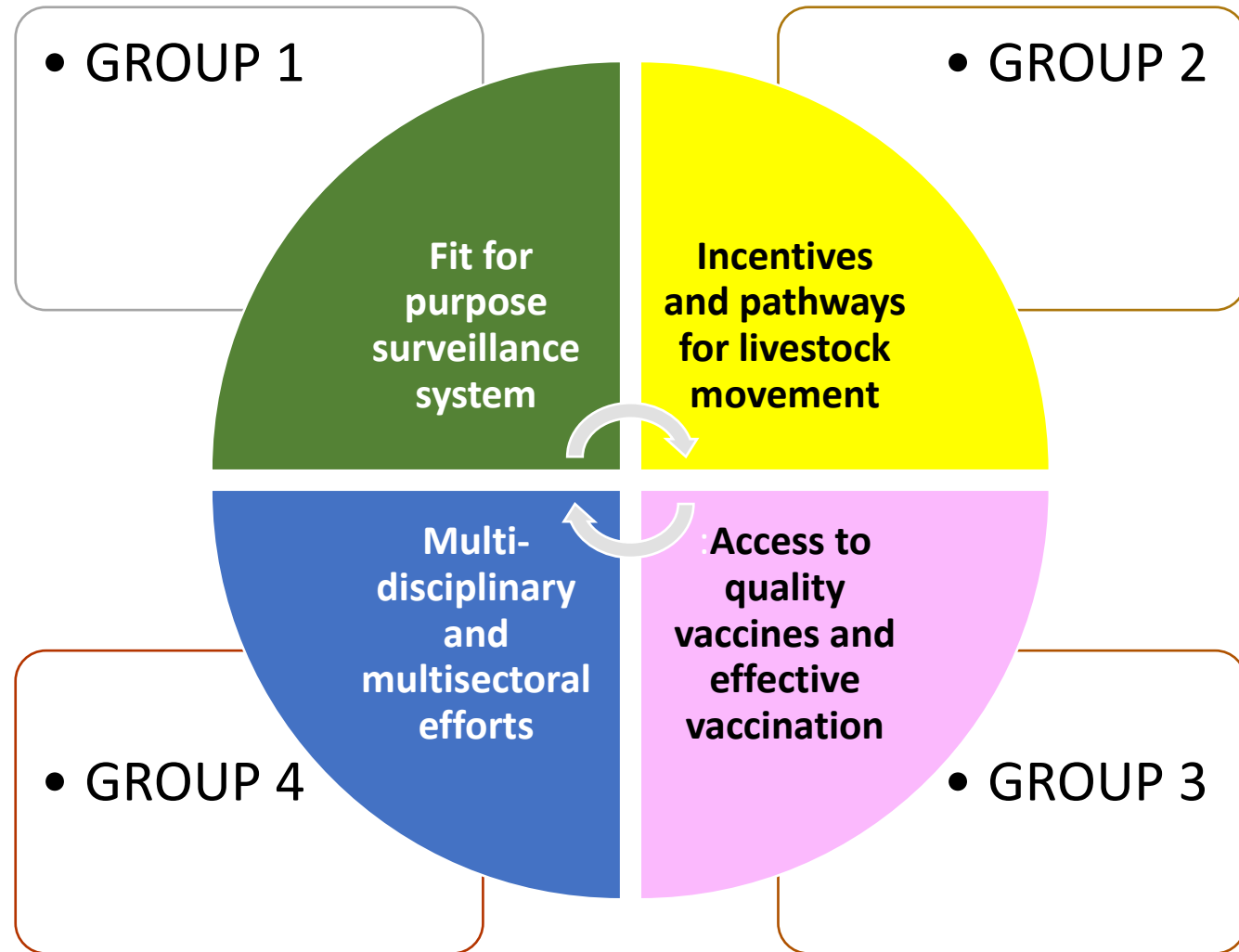
Final addition
