#### Background


SEACFMD Campaign is a regionally coordinated programme to control FMD in the Sub-region.

## **Terms of Reference for the SEACFMD Laboratory Network**

LabNet shall provide technical inputs on disease diagnosis and other laboratory support on the prevention and control of FMD in the region. This will include:

- Rapid diagnosis of FMD viruses
  - $\circ$  Early detection and confirmation of FMD virus serotypes
  - $_{\odot}$  Use of appropriate vaccine strain
- Facilitate sending of field isolates to Reference Labs.
- Strengthen surveillance
  - Molecular epidemiology
  - Mapping on the evolution of FMDV serotypes
- Monitoring vaccine efficacy

- Capacity building on FMD diagnosis
  - $_{\odot}$  Exchange visits of experts
  - $\circ$  Regular training programs
- Harmonization of diagnostic protocols
- Quality assurance system
- Facilitate research activities
  - Prioritize areas for research (eg. role of carrier)
  - Joint research studies
  - $_{\odot}$  Develop proposals for possible funding





## Terms of Reference for the SEACFMD Laboratory Network

- LabNet Members: LabNet Focal persons nominated by the SEACFMD members based on their roles and technical competencies.
- Secretariat to network is provided by WOAH SRR-SEA
- The Regional Expert Group (REG) for FMD will provide guidance to the LabNet.
- Funding: Network including the network meetings is funded by the projects available with WOAH SRR-SEA
- Network meeting In-person before the pandemic and rotated among the Members. Two virtual meetings held during the pandemic.
- During the annual meetings of the SEACFMD Network:
  - the countries will report the status of their laboratory works and the constraints encountered.
  - As a group, the LabNet will come up with common recommendations to overcome the constraints of the countries.
  - Provide platform to share experiences, expertise and new technologies
