









LSD Prevention and Control activities

- Vaccine types: homologous, attenuated
- Source country: Türkiye
- Brand name: LSD-NDOLL
- No. of animals vaccinated: 79,182 cattle and buffalo mainly as routine vaccination and movement purpose



LSD Prevention and Control activities

- Surveillance
 - ✓ Clinical surveillance carried out
- Biosecurity
 - ✓ Disinfection of personnel protective equipment (PPE), vehicles & premises
 - ✓ Quarantine of infected premises
- Movement control
 - ✓ Impose vaccination of susceptible animals prior to movement (inter-state, inter-districts)
 - ✓ Strengthen control of illegal animal movement at international border with other agencies
- Vector control
 - ✓ By fogging and keeping the farm clean from vector breeding sites
- Stamping out
 - ✓ Strengthen the effectiveness of culling by improving compensation rate
- Legislation
 - ✓ Animal Act 1953 (rev. 2013) under Section 18 to 36. LSD is one of 121 notifiable diseases.
- Awareness and communication
 - ✓ Continuous and comprehensive public awareness campaign conducted seminar, dissemination of information through social media such as FB, Instagram, poster, banner, pamphlets and direct communication to the farmers
 - ✓ Increase knowledge and awareness among stakeholder (traders, farmers, butchers etc) and extension staffs on economic impact of LSD

Main challenges and recommended solution

Main challenges

- Animal farming system >85% is smallholder / backyard with less or no biosecurity measure
- Low cooperation among farmers in vaccinating their animals (due to neethling response that will lower the price of animal & their perception that only one vaccination during the life of a cattle)
- Illegal animal movement among traders
- Lack of awareness & knowledge on economic impact of LSD among farmers

Recommended solution

- Awareness on biosecurity management
- Promote GAHP
- Continuous awareness campaign, continuous field staff education
