


Background

Regulatory framework, policies, procedures and trade environment



1.CVO of exporting country shall send an official requested letter to export live animals and/or animal products to Director General of DLD.



2. The request shall be considered by Market Access committee.



3. DLD will sending questionnaire to evaluate animal health/public health.



4. The completed questionnaire shall be submitted to Food Safety and Risk Assessment Committee, and Expert on Livestock Development for a Specific Animal Type for risk assessment.



5.DLD inspector team will conduct an inspection audit to the establishment after pre-onsite questionnaire has been completed.

6. The DLD auditor team shall submit the audit report to the Market Access committee for consideration.



7.DLD shall send the improved import Requirements to CVO of exporting country.




8. The CVO of exporting country shall send draft Health Certificate /Electronic health certificate in compliance with the import requirements to be approved by DLD.



9. The DLD formally submit the detail of country and approved farms /establishments on DLD website.



- Disease zone announcement
- Requests permission to enter the area

The system will show the expiration date and time of the documents

 The domestic movement document valid for 48 hours after issued
