


General information

- There is 1 animal diseases control zone to promoted big ruminant trade between Lao and China





Animal movement pattern through Lao


Requirement for Import, export or transit

- Import, Export or transit request document
- Personal or company documents(ID, business doc..)
- Health certificate and Lab results
- Request
- Invoice
- Quarantine doc
- Vaccination certificate

Activities in Collection zone

- 1) At least 45 days stayed in
- 2) Ear tagging
- 3) 2 vaccinations for FMD and LSD
- 4) Routine Health Examination
- 5) Sample collection ຂຶ້ນທະບຽນພິມສັດ,



Activities in buffer zone

- 1) Ear tagging
- 2) 2 vaccinations for FMD and LSD a year
- 3) Post vaccination 2 time a year



Activities in Quarantine Station

- 1) At least 30 days stayed in
- 2) Ear tag checking
- 3) Routine Health Examination
- 4) 10% of Blood sample collection from export cattle to test for herd immunity after 2 vaccinations from collection zone
- 5) 30 sentinel animal(cattle) with non FMD immunity positive, NSP checking every 3 months
