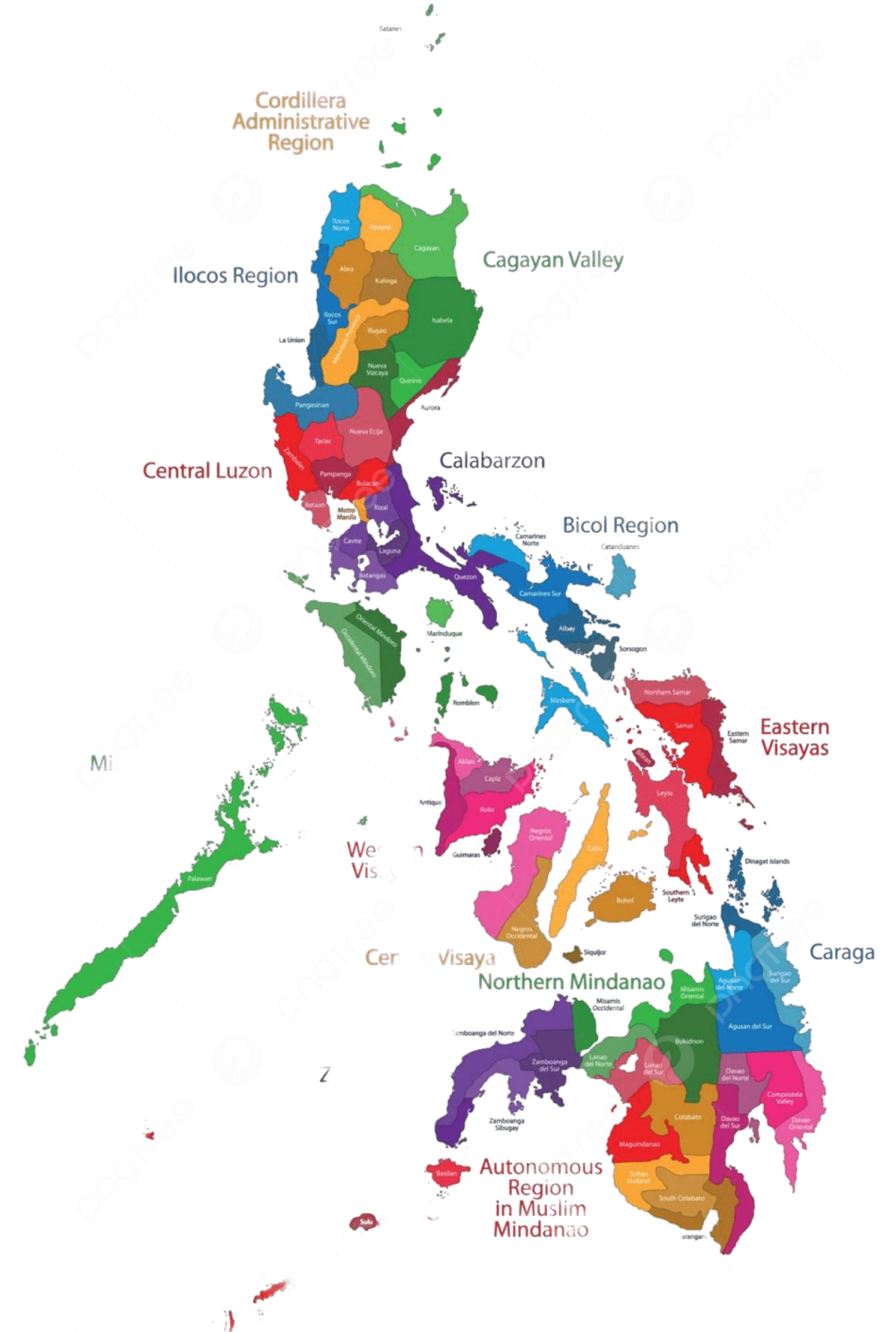

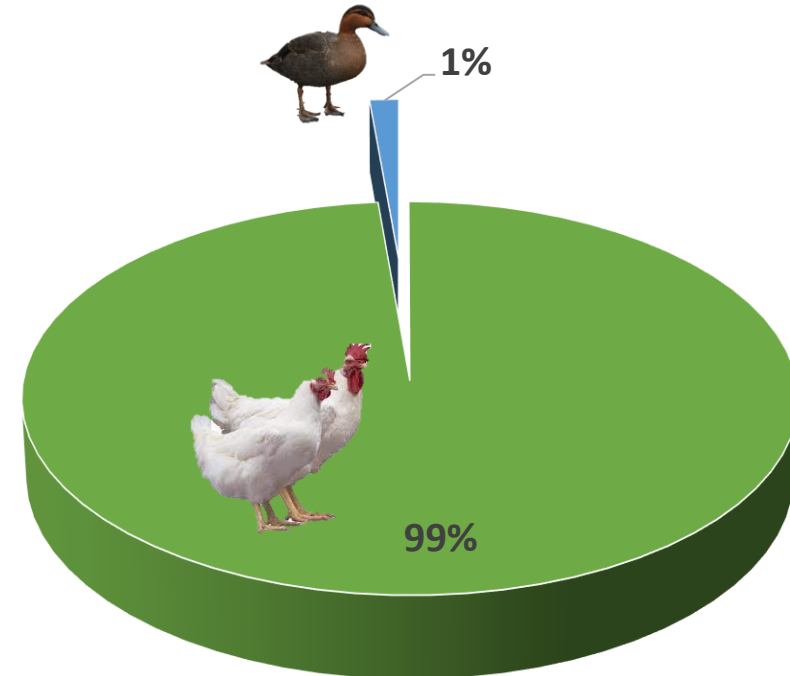

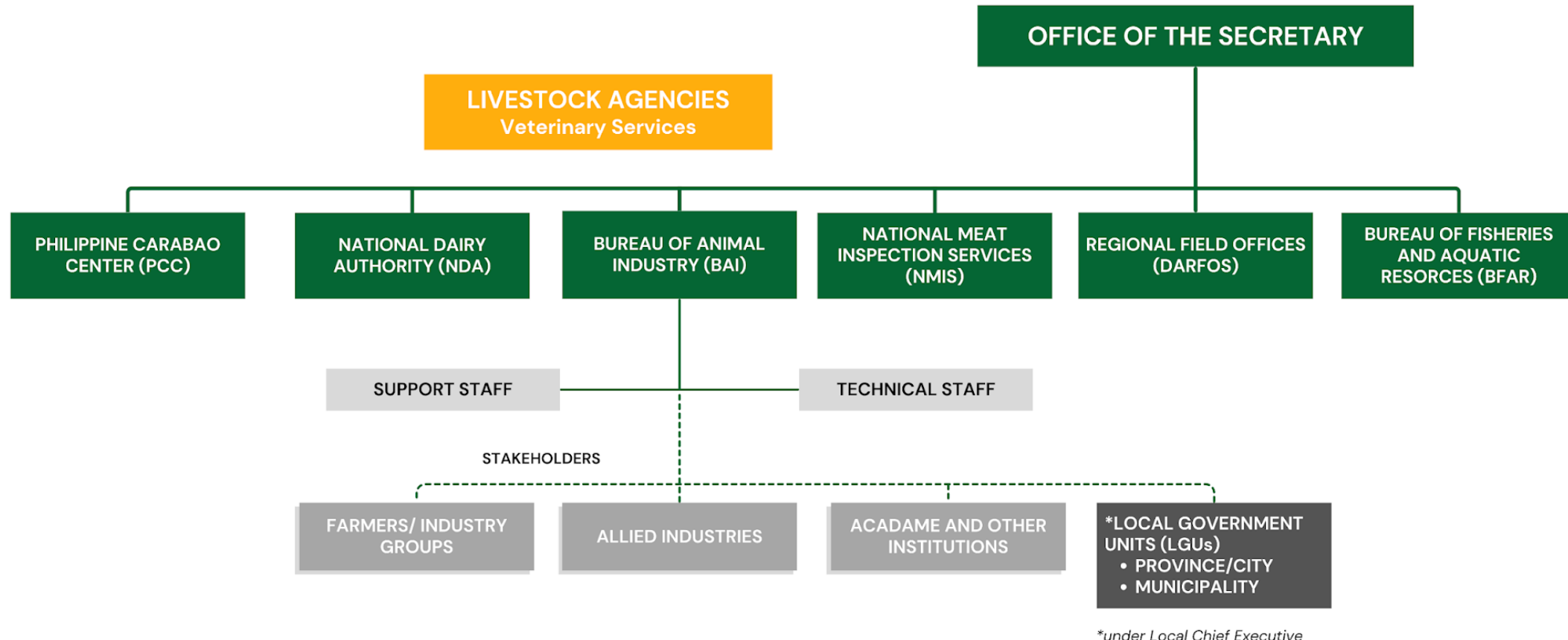

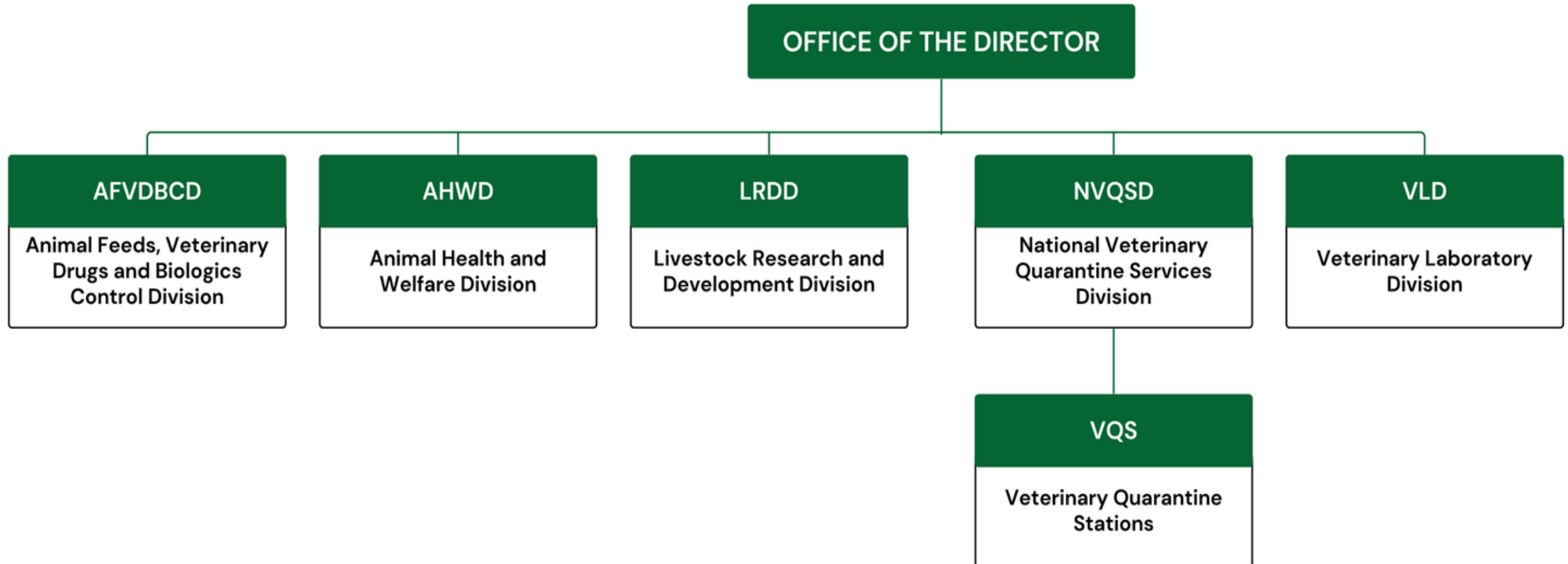

Veterinary Quarantine Stations (VQS)

- Veterinary quarantine in:
 - 97 domestic seaports
 - 79 international seaport
 - 31 domestic airports
 - 14 international airports
 - 32 quarantine checkpoints in strategic regional boundaries
- 16 Regional Veterinary Quarantine Stations and 4 Stations in NCR

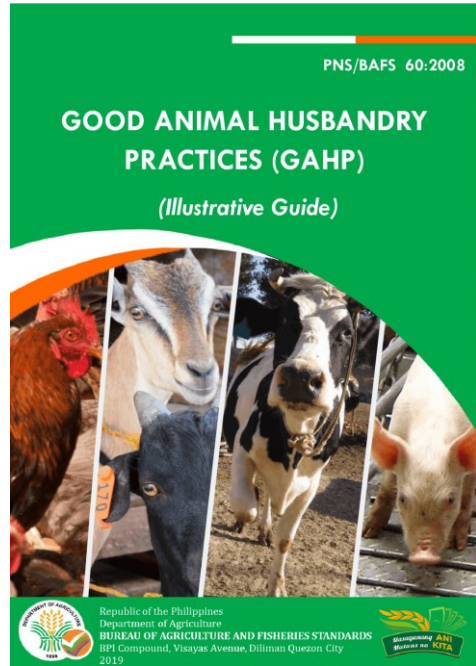

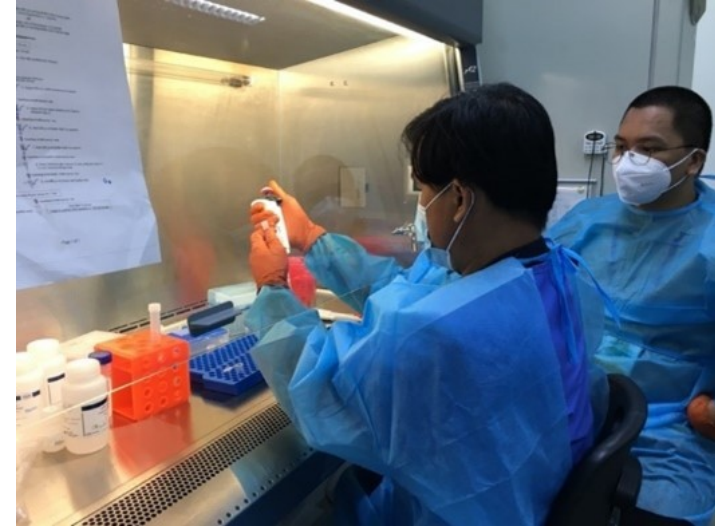
1. Licensing of Animal, Animal – Product and Animal By-Product Exporters
2. All export commodities are ensured to have originated from facilities that passed the Animal health and welfare standards of the Philippines.



Philippines Veterinary Service & its Exports

Conformity with International Standards

1. Technical Assistance to exporters in coordinating with importing country of requirements, if necessary, assistance for inspection mission
2. Issuance of Export Certificates and other relevant documentation or certification required.

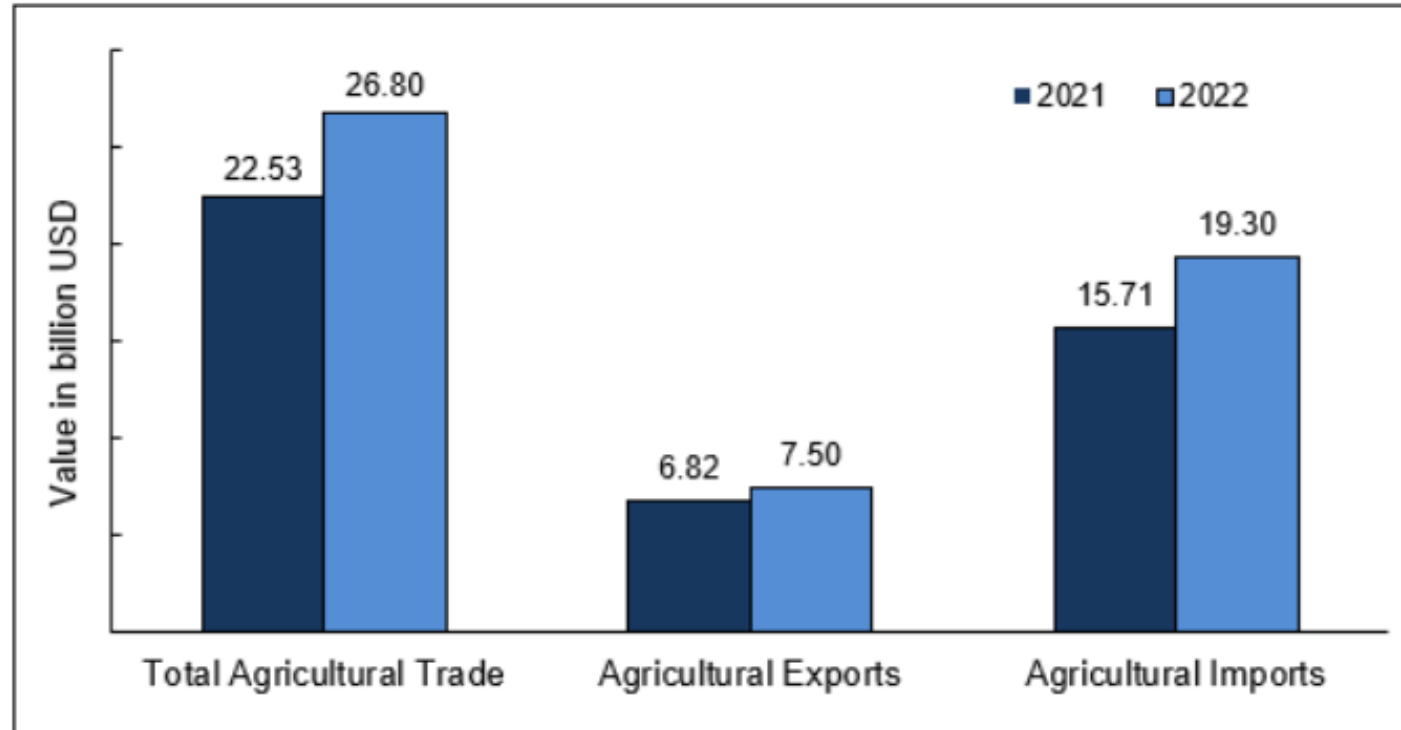

The country's agricultural export revenue rose to USD 7.50 billion or by 10.0 percent annual rate in 2022 from USD 6.82 billion agricultural export revenue in 2021. In 2022, the value of agricultural exports accounted for 9.5 percent of the country's total export.
