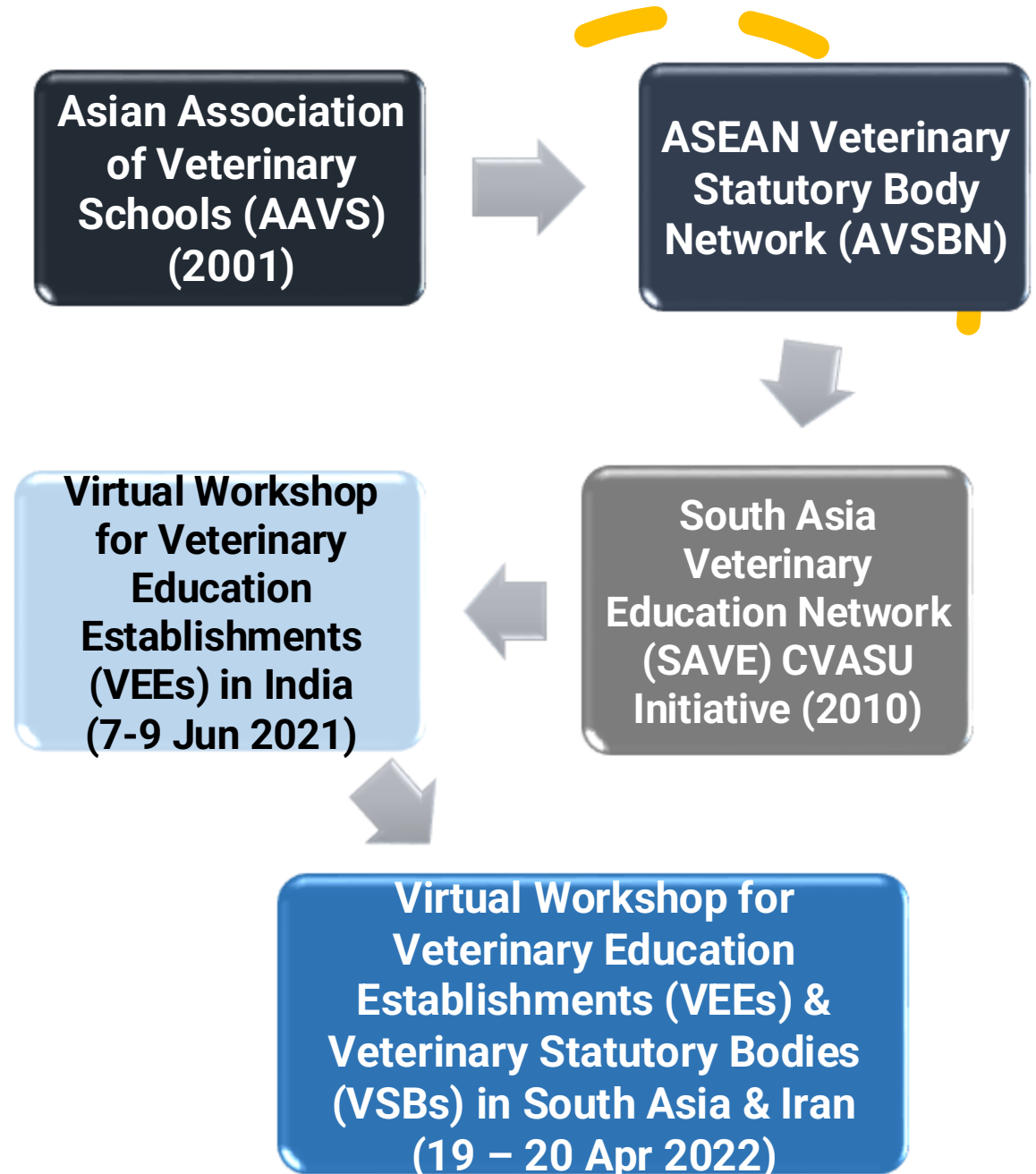

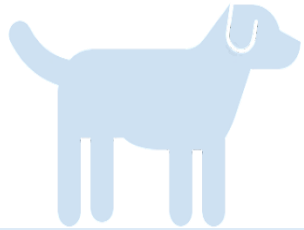
Objectives

Executive Committee

- **15 focal points of VEEs & VSBs (selected by CVOs)**
- **Chair, Co-chair, Secretary General & Members**
- **Two-year term**

Executive Committee ToRs

1. Schedule meetings to discuss the set agenda & strategize future actions

2. Contact point for any communication among the VEEs within the member country through the focal points from respective countries

3. Address any setbacks in completing the defined activities & **implement a comprehensive resolution strategy**

4. Commemorate World Veterinary Day to raise awareness & importance about veterinary education & profession

5. Establish a collaborative partnership with other VEEs/VSBs network & **conduct regular virtual or face-to-face meetings** to exchange views & updates

6. Develop plans to raise funds from international donors

7. Set up sub-committees to oversee certain specific functions like student/faculty exchange, curriculum review
