





- Chapter IV Emergency Management
 - China employs a tiered management approach for responding to major animal epidemics, requiring local governments to implement appropriate emergency control measures according to the severity level outlined in the

emergency plan.

Issues reported:

- 2021.03.27 ASF was found in pigs illegally transported from other provinces in Changsha, Hunan Province, China
- 2021.03.09 ASF was detected in piglets illegally transported from other provinces in Huaying, Sichuan Province, China
- 2020.04.02 An ASF epidemic occurred in Longnan, Gansu province, China
- 2021.04.05 The Xinjiang, China, reported an outbreak of ASF
- 2021.04.29 An ASF outbreak has been reported Baotou City, Inner Mongolia, China
