In response to the ASF outbreaks in the country, the Department of Agriculture (DA) – Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI) implemented the National ASF Prevention and Control Program (NASFPCC). The program outlines a five-pronged community-based approach involving:

1. Strengthening and institutionalizing **LGU engagement**;
2. Intensifying **surveillance**, risk assessment, and monitoring of ASF cases;
3. Strengthening **biosecurity** implementation, especially in smallhold swine farms;
4. Conducting capability-building programs and **awareness** campaigns; and
5. Supporting recovery and **repopulation** activities and programs.



ASF PREVENTION & CONTROL MEASURES

CONSTRAINTS

Incoherence of legislation or law relative to animal disease control between the national and some local government policies leading to non-compliance of stakeholders.

Dissatisfaction of stakeholders and farmers to ASF compensation/indemnification scheme of the government.

Lack of a national comprehensive animal identification and traceability system of animals, products and by-products.

Misinformation and disinformation on ASF resulting to differences in understanding and appreciation of the program.

SOLUTIONS

Re-centralization of the agriculture sector including veterinary services with the main objective of harmonized program implementation.

Strengthen stakeholder engagement, from policy development to monitoring and evaluation of the program.

Improve public awareness including conduct of assessments of the communication plan with various stakeholders (government and private) to address gaps and challenges.
