


# ASF SITUATION

### Spatial patterns of ASF in Thailand

#### 35 out of 77 Provinces


### Temporal patterns of ASF in Thailand





Between 2022 and 2024, a total of 114 outbreaks were reported across 35 provinces, as illustrated on the map. In 2023 and 2024, sporadic cases were observed in smallholder pig farms. These incidents were associated with a traditional tribal festival during which villagers slaughtered backyard pigs as part of their

celebrations.



### Infected Premise (IP)

**Quarantine and Segregation** 

#### **Destruction of Affected Animals**

• Backyard farms (≤50 pigs) and small farms (>50 pigs but ≤500 pigs) must destroy all pigs Medium farms (≤5,000 pigs) and large farms (>5,000 pigs) destroy the pigs in batch that test positive.

# ASF PREVENTION & CONTROL MEASURES

## Protective Zone (PZ)

Clinical surveillance in the area (1 km.)  $\checkmark$ 

If pigs are found to be sick or dead abnormally, or if they meet the definition of the disease,

IP = infected premise

PZ = protective zone

SZ = surveillance zone

take immediate action to control the disease.

## Surveillance Zone (SZ)

Disease surveillance extends to active searching by visiting farmers. Any abnormalities found during these visits require sample collection for confirmation.

## CONSTRAINTS & SOLUTIONS

#### Low biosecurity practices in small holders



Encourage farmers to improve their farm biosecurity from low biosecurity practices to basis GFM (Good Farming Management).






### Insufficient manpower
