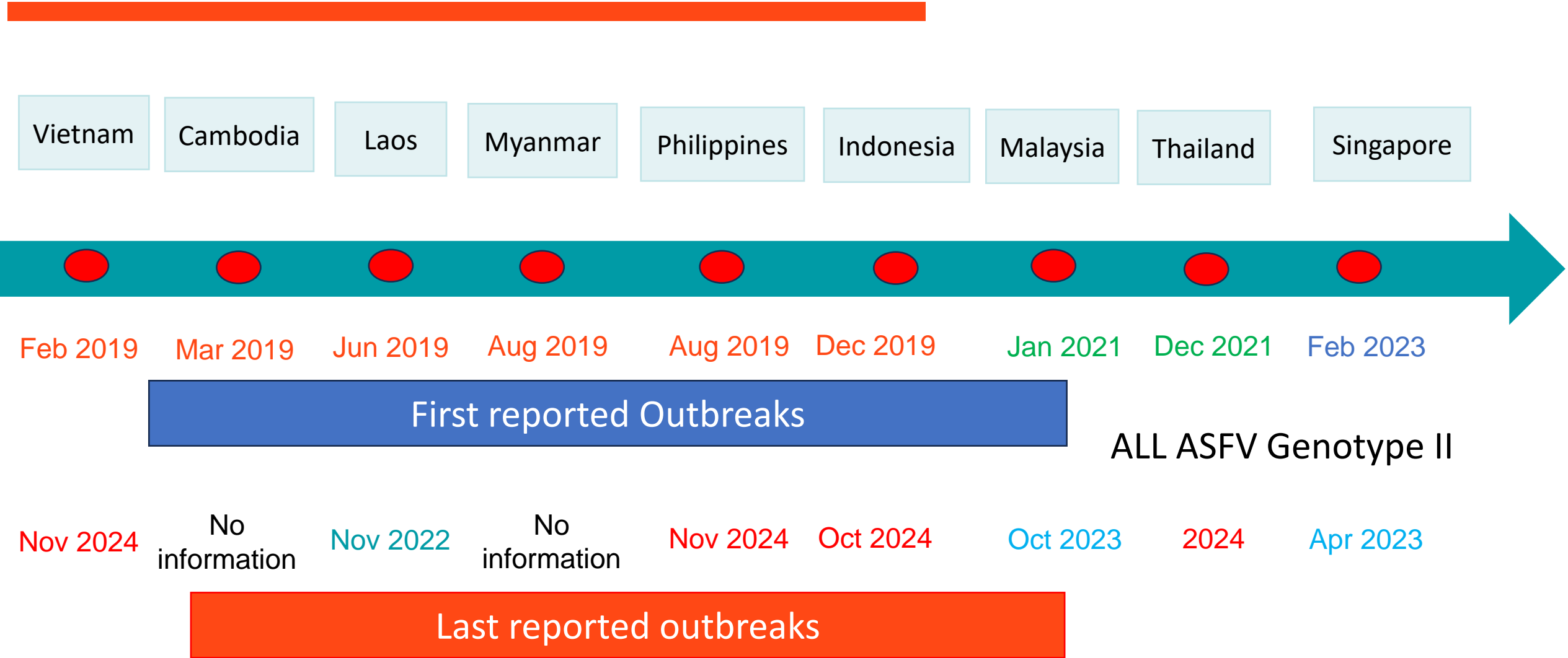

ASF incursion in Asia and the Pacific region

- 9 AMS and PR China submitted poster
- Brunei – no ASF outbreak reported
- August 2018 – ASF outbreak in China and then spread to other countries in Asia-Pacific region
- ASF Virus GII in all Members
- China reported ASF GI virus in 2021
- 19 Members in Asia-Pacific region affected by ASF

Key ASF prevention and control interventions

- Outbreak investigation and response
- Surveillance
- Lab diagnostic capacity
- Biosecurity – Community based Biosecurity intervention (CABI) in Philippines, CABI piloted in Indonesia and Laos
- Movement control
- Lab diagnostic capacity – PCR capacity by all Members
- Contingency Plan
- Simulation exercise
- Legislation
- Communication and advocacy
- Value chain analysis
- Compartmentalisation
- Restocking

Key challenges

- Poor biosecurity in backyard and small farms
- Illegal movement of pigs and pork products
- Fund shortage
- Illegal trade
- Poor reporting
- Inadequate private sector engagement
- Effective vaccines?
- Insufficient manpower
- Huge investment costs for biosecurity measures in big commercial farms, thus increasing production cost;
- Lack of comprehensive traceability and identification system
- Misinformation and disinformation on ASF

Recommended solutions

- Improve biosecurity
- Movement control
- Legislation
- Promote private sector engagement – PPP
- Enhance Lab capacities – PT programme
- Improve biosecurity – CABI and compartments
- Risk-based ASF Control Strategy
