VACCINES REGULATION



- The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) issued the Certificate of Product Registration under Monitored Release (CPR-MR) for ASF Live – Attenuated Vaccine on July 11, 2024 and valid until July 11, 2026.
- The CPR is granted under special conditions pending full commercial registration/market authorization.
- The vaccine is to be used exclusively by the DA-BAI and in eligible swine farms, adhering strictly to the current vaccination guidelines established by the national veterinary authority.
- Use of the product is restricted in specific areas/zones in accordance with national animal health policies.

Current Status and Updates

- The DA has allocated ₱240 million for the procurement of 500,000 doses of ASF vaccines which includes vaccination paraphernalia, cold storage facility, test kits, logistics and IEC.
- The first vaccination under monitored use was conducted on August 30, 2024, in two backyard farms located in Lobo, Batangas.
- A total of 1,994 doses have been administered (as of Nov. 20, 2024), with additional farms scheduled for vaccination in the coming weeks.



DA, BAI START CONTROLLED VACCINE ADMINISTRATION TO COMBAT AFRICAN SWINE FEVER SPREAD

The Department of Agriculture on Friday, (August 30, 2024) kicked off the controlled administration of a Vietnam-developed African Swine Fever live vaccine in Lobo, Batangas —a municipality with one of the highest cases of ASF.

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Challenges Encountered:

Farmers and some LGUs' Hesitancy to do ASF Vaccination

1. Pigs might be condemned if turned positive on initial blood test
2. Multiple blood test will compromise biosecurity and stress the pigs
3. DA-BAI will find out if they are using illegally purchased ASF vaccine
4. Documentary requirements for applicant farms to accomplish before vaccine are given
5. Surveillance in area around diseased and vaccinated animals with limited DIVA kits
