What is Substandard Falsified Veterinary Medicine (SFVP)?

- Ineffective treatments prolong illness and increase mortality.
- Substandard antibiotics contribute to antimicrobial resistance (AMR).
- Farmers face economic losses from disease outbreaks and failed treatments.
- Public health risks arise from drug residues in food and zoonotic disease spread.

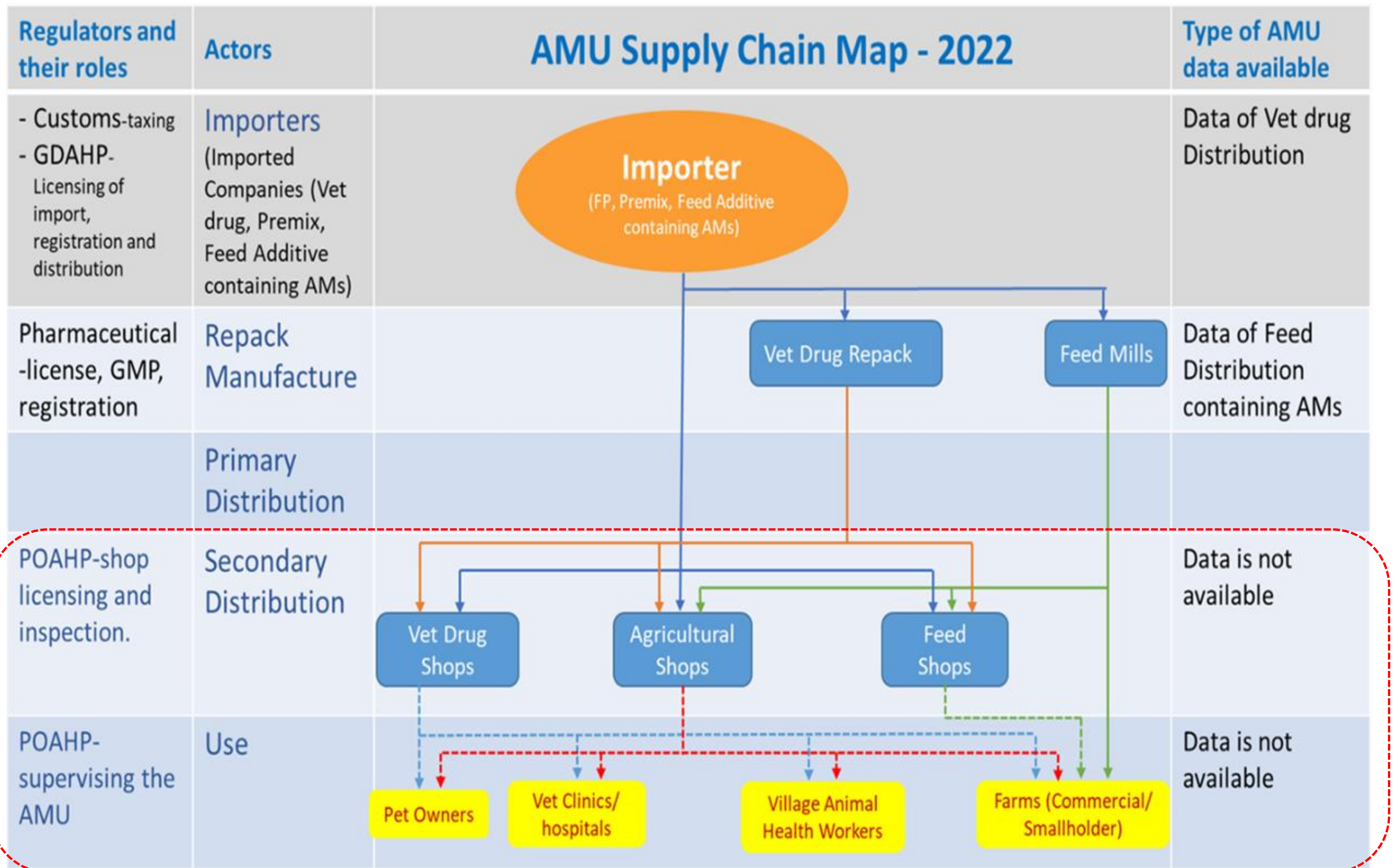
