WOAH's 8th Strategic Plan:

A collective roadmap

A shared strategic ambition:

- □ **Define our collective priorities** for the next 5 years, around **strategic pillars** with measurable objectives, outcomes, indicators and targets.
- □ Align these priorities with WOAH's mandate in an uncertain international environment.

An inclusive and mobilising process:

- **Built with Members**, partners and teams, from the earliest stages.
- Active involvement of Members in the design, implementation and evaluation of the Plan.
- **Concrete implementation** in annual roadmaps at Headquarters and Regional levels.
- □ A resource mobilisation strategy, aligned with the Plan's priorities, to ensure its effective implementation.

A strategic tool for action:

- □ For Members: a common basis for guiding national policies, strengthening veterinary services and acting collectively on cross-cutting challenges (climate, single health, trade, etc.)
- □ For Donors: a clear, coherent and measurable framework to justify investment and monitor impact.





Key findings in all Regions

1st common strategic topic



Africa (AF) : Develop and maintain **sanitary standards** that can be implemented under challenging conditions and in line with regional operational needs.

Americas (AM) : Maintain high quality Animal Health and Welfare **standards for trade**.

<u>Asia-Pacific (AP) :</u> Maintain trusted and safe trade and robust standards for disease control.

Europe (EU) : Achieve robust, science-based and trusted standards.

Middle-East (ME) : Strengthen the impact and relevance of standards for trade and for Members' regional needs.



2nd common strategic topic



AF: Enable a coordinated, harmonised and adapted **approach to managing transboundary animal diseases** at regional level and in line with global strategies.

AM: Provide tailored support to **VS** at regional level.

<u>AP:</u> Strengthening Animal Health and Welfare services through strategic capacity building and preparedness.

EU: Advance **animal health and welfare systems** through capacity-building and cooperation.

ME: Strengthen the global animal health system.

3rd common strategic topic

AF: Increase the relevance of WOAH's disease prevention and control **leadership** role in the current global situation. + *Enabler:* **Advocacy** and strategic **communications** between WOAH and governments


AM :Increase **visibility and importance** of AH to tackle global issues

<u>AP:</u> Elevate role and **contribution** of AH services to national security issues and **global challenges**

+ Enabler: Robust **information** policies, systems and tools for impactful risk communication, **advocacy** and stakeholder engagement

EU: Improve **global visibility and recognition** of AH & W services to increase their impact and credibility in times of crisis

ME: Advocacy to increase WOAH's global relevance, **visibility and technical leadership**.





AF : **Leverage** systems and opportunities to increase financial resources.



2nd common enabler




AF: Leverage systems and opportunities to increase financial resources.

EU: Data systems and platforms to optimise resources and empower decision-makers


