Nayana graduated as a veterinarian from the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine and Animal Science, University of Peradeniya, Sri Lanka and then pursued her PhD in Pharmacology from Auburn University, Unites States of America in 2007. She then joined the University of Peradeniya as a senior Lecturer, and now serves as a Professor in Veterinary Clinical Sciences.

She has been leading the Curriculum Revision and Implementation Committee of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine & Animal Science and have partnered with Massey University of New Zealand under the OIE Twinning Programme to revise the BVSc curriculum to align with international veterinary curricula. She was the Head of Department of Veterinary Clinical Sciences in the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine & Animal Science, University of Peradeniya. She also represents Asia in the Council of International Vet Medical Education (CIVME) established under the Association of American Veterinary Medical Colleges (AAVMC).

Nayana serves as the chairperson of the Veterinary Education Research Working Group, in the Association of Asian Veterinary Schools. She is an Adjunct Senior Lecturer to the School of Veterinary Science at Massey University, New Zealand and served as a visiting Academic Professor at the Royal Veterinary College, London, United Kingdom. She is also a Fellow in College of Veterinary Surgeons in Sri Lanka. She serves as an Editorial Board Member to the RCVS's Veterinary Evidence Journal.
