Dr. JPS Gill, graduated as a veterinarian and then pursued his PhD in Veterinary Public Health and Epidemiology from PAU, Ludhiana. He assumed the role of Vice Chancellor, Guru Angad Dev Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (GADVASU), in September 2024. Previously, he held positions of Director of Research, Director of School of Public Health & Zoonoses and Head of Veterinary Public Health and Epidemiology department at GADVASU, Ludhiana. He has also served as an Adjunct Professor at the Western College of Veterinary Medicine, University of Saskatchewan, Canada. Dr Gill played a significant role in drafting undergraduate and post graduate courses for Veterinary Sciences in India.

With over 35 years of experience, Dr. Gill is a valued member of several global and national expert panels including Joint FAO/WHO Expert Meetings on Foodborne AMR, the European Commission TOM Steering Committee of FAO for Control of FMD, Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) scientific panels, and committees of WHO, Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), and Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), Govt. of India. He has also played a pivotal role in shaping India's National Action Plan on AMR and the Roadmap to Combat Zoonoses in India.

Dr. Gill has successfully led 11 International and over 30 National research projects coordinating multidisciplinary teams across multiple countries and states. He is Fellow of the National Academy of Veterinary Sciences and Indian Association of Veterinary Public Health Specialists and contributed significantly to Veterinary Science and Public Health in India and beyond.
