

## Armando E. Hoet, DVM, PhD, DACVPM



Dr. Hoet is the founder (2005) and Director of the **Veterinary Public Health program** at Ohio State University (<http://vet.osu.edu/education/veterinary-public-health-program>), which is ACVPM accredited and second largest program of its kind in the USA.

He is the Team leader of the [WOAH Twinning Program in Ethiopia](#), helping to create the [first WOAHA harmonized veterinary curriculum in Africa](#). Currently, with the support of the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation (BMGF), he is helping all 20 veterinary schools in Ethiopia in [the implementation of their new national curriculum](#), launching on May 2025 the [Veterinary Education National Action Plan for the 2020 Harmonized Veterinary National Curriculum VEd-NAP 2025-2028](#).

In 2019, the [AID-1C project](#) was expanded to SE Asia, establishing hubs in Thailand, and the Philippines to serve 7 countries in the region, which included multiple curricular assessment workshops involving representatives 41 veterinary schools. These workshops were a part of the [Assessment of Day-1 Competencies \(AID-1C\) methodology](#) that Dr. Hoet developed through the Veterinary Education Twinning Program.
