

Asst. Prof. Dr. Khongsak Thiangtum is the Dean of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine at Kasetsart University, Thailand. He earned his Doctor of Veterinary Medicine (D.V.M.) degree from Kasetsart University in 1996, followed by a Master of Science and a Ph.D. in Agricultural Biotechnology in 2005 and 2012, respectively.

Dr. Khongsak began his academic career as a lecturer at Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Kasetsart University, and later became the Director of the Kasetsart University Veterinary Teaching Hospital Kamphaeng Saen, Nakhon Pathom province and the Kasetsart University Veterinary Teaching Hospital Hua Hin, Prachuap Khiri Khan province. Since 2017, he has served as Dean of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Kasetsart University. He currently holds prominent leadership roles as President of the Consortium of Veterinary Deans of Thailand and President of the Southeast Asia Veterinary Schools Association (SEAVSA), reflecting his commitment to regional and national collaboration in veterinary education.

His academic interests include feline reproduction, animal welfare and veterinary ethics. Dr. Khongsak led multiple initiatives to promote one health approach including rabies elimination project in Thailand. In 2022, he was honored with the Outstanding Alumnus Award from Kasetsart University for his contributions to public health and veterinary advancement.
