ASSIGNMENT: INDIVIDUAL CONSULTANT TO SUPPORT WOAHP ACTIVITIES IN INDONESIA

Context

The World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH – founded as OIE) is a leading intergovernmental organisation representing 183 Members worldwide. Through its activities, WOAH makes a decisive contribution to improving animal health, protecting animal welfare and strengthening Veterinary Services. The Organisation provides transparent information on world's animal health situation, and promotes international standards, particularly in terms of the safety of trade in live animals and animal products. Joining WOAH means taking part in the development of one of the leading international organisations, recognised and associated with other multilateral institutions, in the field of worldwide health. It means helping to build a global approach to health, combining animal and human health in a "One Health" approach.

To support its work, WOAH may use individual consultants to provide ad hoc support for tasks that cannot be carried out by members of its staff. An individual consultant works in his own name, for the duration of his assignment at WOAH, to the exclusion of any other principal and without being attached to any employer.

WOAH's headquarters are based in Paris. The Organisation is present on every continent through 13 Regional or Sub-regional Representations. WOAH has 250 staff members, two-thirds of whom are based at headquarters. The WOAH Sub-Regional Representation for South-East Asia (SRR SEA) is located in Bangkok and is composed of a team of 11 staff. WOAH SRR SEA is implementing numerous activities in Indonesia in collaboration with the Directorate General of Livestock and Animal Health Services (DGLAHS) and would require additional local support to strengthen its action in this country. While the Individual Consultant will report to the team in Bangkok, he/she should be based in Indonesia to facilitate the work in this country. The Individual Consultant will work equivalent part time.

The Consultant's mission will begin as soon as the selection procedure is finalised, possibly on September 1, 2025.

Description of the individual consultant assignment

Reporting

Reporting to the Sub-Regional Representative for South East Asia, the Individual Consultant will work under the direct supervision of the technical teams at SRR SEA.

Mission objectives

The Individual Consultant supports the implementation of WOAH activities in Indonesia related to Transboundary Animal Diseases (TADs), capacity building and One Health. This involves supporting the team based in Bangkok in planning, coordinating, and ensuring the effective delivery of these activities. The role involves fostering strong working relationships with DGLAHS and other national stakeholders in Indonesia contributing to the success of activities and enhancing the visibility of WOAH and its initiatives.

Activities and deliverables

Contribute to WOAH activities in Indonesia

- Provide technical and logistical support for the WOAH activities, which include but are not limited to disease surveillance, control and prevention, risk assessments, vaccination campaigns, outbreak investigations, disease control plan strategy developments and its implementation, capacity building

Offer / Individual consultant

- Support implementation of WOA activities related to TADs (FMD, ASF, PPR, LSD...), Capacity building (PVS Pathway, Emergency management) and One health (Rabies, wildlife Health, AMR....);
- Plan, coordinate, prepare, facilitate and report on relevant WOA meetings, workshops, trainings and other relevant events in Indonesia.
- Contribute to drafting progress and annual reports of projects implemented by WOA SRR-SEA in Indonesia in accordance with donor requirements.

Ensure presence and network in Indonesia

- Maintain working relations with stakeholders in Indonesia, including but not limited to: DGLAHS, the ASEAN, CIVAS, other Government officials, research institutes, academia, industry and farmers;
- Oversee and monitor activities being implemented by other project partners in Indonesia and neighbouring countries (including Malaysia and Timor Leste) to develop collaboration and find synergies;
- Participate in relevant national, regional and international meetings, seminars and conferences, located in Indonesia and promote the visibility of WOA as an independent, scientific and highly professional organisation throughout South-East Asia;
- Liaise and attend meetings at the ASEAN Headquarters based in Jakarta when needed.

In addition, the Sub-Regional Representative for South East Asia may when necessary, assign to the incumbent any other duties, responsibilities and activities within her/his area of competence.

Requirements

Qualifications and experience

Qualifications required

- A degree in Veterinary Medicine, with MS or PhD an advantage;
- At least five years of work experience with exposure in an international arena;
- Proven experience in managing animal health programmes and projects, including with monitoring and evaluation in Indonesia.

Expected skills

Technical skills

- Knowledge and understanding of the nature and epidemiology of important TADS such as FMD, ASF, LSD and other TADS;
- Knowledge and understanding of the nature and epidemiology of zoonotic diseases and the One Health approach;
- Experience managing capacity building programmes including technical assistance, training, mentorship, knowledge sharing.
- Experience in planning and coordinating internal and external meetings (virtual and presential);
- Excellent command of English, both written and spoken, including scientific, technical and project report writing.
- Excellent command of Bahasa Indonesia, both written and spoken, including scientific, technical and project report writing.
- Strong computer skills in a Microsoft environment (Word, Excel, PPT), SharePoint

Personal and interpersonal skills

- Strong network in Indonesia among public Veterinary Services, private Veterinary sector and related national and international partners;
- Excellent analytical, facilitation, coordination and communication skills;

- Proven effective organisational skills and ability to handle work in an efficient and timely manner; defining priorities and meeting deadlines;
- Capacity to work autonomously and to take ownership of tasks.
