





### Good Practices in Border Inspection and Quarantine

- Please describe effective practices and experiences in implementing border inspection and quarantine measures.
  - Successful approaches or innovations
  - Checking document carefully: HC include origin, disease status (free status: FMD, ASF, AI, AHPND, WSD, IHHND,...), detail of based on Agreement between Countries
  - Apply high technology: Online registration, Using digital HC, PR code ....
  - Follow the regulation on: Checking the situation of goods, sanitary, sampling and test.
  - Good Collaborate and sharing information with: Department of Fisheries and surveillance, Department of Forestry, Department of Quality, Processing and market development, Custom, Border Guard, Public Health.



### Good Practices in Border Inspection and Quarantine

- Lessons learned from past experiences
- Check careful HC (Form, certification content...)
- Inspecting clinical of animal, situation of animal products by Vet they had experiences to see abnormal of animal and animal products.
- Combination with Customs and border Police to prevent illegal transport animal and animal products.
- Replicable models for other countries/territories
   If a country had outbreak with dangerous infectious disease:
- Suspend the Issuance of quarantine certificate (Animal health Law 2015).
- They must ban to inspect and stop make the HC for movement in their country and export.
- Announcing to other countries they import animal and animal products from them.



## Challenges and risks identified

- Resource limitations
- **Human resource:** Limited in number and qualifications. The legal awareness and educational level of ethnic minorities in border areas remains low, staff.
- The border is very long with another countries (4.616km land border line, 3.260 Coastal line): Lao, Cambodia, China.
- Financial resources and supporting facilities:
  - Lack of funding for implementing post-import scientific monitoring programs and software to support quarantine operations;
  - Lack of funding for building border fences.
  - Some areas lack baggage screening machines (informal border crossing path), sniffer dogs, ...; animal quarantine facilities depend on the establishment owners.



## Challenges and risks identified

- Risk of transboundary animal diseases
- Fraud in the illegal transport of animals and animal products
- Many animals are in the incubation period or have recently been exposed to pathogens, reducing the effectiveness of disease control at borders
- Lack of disease information, especially regarding newly emerging diseases, if not notified by the competent authority of the exporting country (ex.: EMS/AHPND, TPD, DIV1 on shrimp ...)
- Wild animals cannot be controlled (no fences/barriers in some area), so diseases may be transmitted.
- Informal/illegal movement
- illegal transport animal and animal products are sometime happen



### Collaboration with other agencies

- Collaboration between animal quarantine and other relevant agencies for effective border control.
  - Purpose of Collaboration
  - Strictly control, promptly detect and prevent transboundary transmission of animal diseases
  - Control the transport of animals and animal products in accordance with legal regulations
  - Prevent illegal activities in the transport of animals and animal products across the border
  - Inspection and supervision work does not stop at peak periods. It must be maintained regularly and continuously.
  - The peoples live at area border if seeing an illegal movement they should announce to animal quarantine, police.
  - Ensure food safety.



### Collaboration with other agencies

- . Key Partners
- Customs: they check all of lugages, means of transport...
- Border police: they check and arrest of people if they move the baned animal and products.
- Media, express agency usually regularly publish legal regulations (veterinary law, Customs law...) to the peoples.
- Provincial People's Committees of border provinces (Departments of Agriculture and Environment, Police ..): Coordinate in the prevention and control of smuggling of animals and animal products; raise awareness among local people and businesses about relevant regulations
- Local people: Provide information, support, and coordinate in the prevention of illegal cross-border transport of animals and animal products.

#### . Examples of Joint Activities

The National Steering Committee on Anti-Smuggling, Trade Fraud and Counterfeit Goods was established by the Prime Minister (Decision No. 389/QĐ-TTg dated March 19, 2014, including animals and animal products, Deputy Prime minister – Leader, Minister of MAE- Member).

- A continuous inter-agency coordination and direction mechanism is in place, operating from the central to local levels to prevent smuggling, trade fraud, and counterfeit goods.
- The activities are carried out on an ongoing basis, with peak action months organized annually.
- The role of the DAHP: directly participate in peak campaigns, conducting inspections at border gates and key areas related to the transport of smuggled, counterfeit, or unidentified-origin animals and animal products.



#### . Benefits

- Strengthened leadership and inter-agency coordination: mobilizing interagency forces including police, customs, border guards, veterinary authorities, market surveillance, agriculture officials
- Enhance the effectiveness of preventing and controlling transboundary disease transmission while ensuring food safety.
- The coordination is carried out continuously, clearly, proactively, and with well-defined responsibilities among all relevant parties.
