

Terms of Reference for the WOAH National Focal Point for Aquatic Animals

Details on proposed tasks of the national focal point for aquatic animals:

- 1. to establish a network of aquatic animal health experts within his/her country or to communicate with the existing network;
- 2. to establish and maintain a dialogue with the Competent Authority for aquatic animal health in his/her country, and to facilitate cooperation and communication among several authorities where responsibility is shared;
- under the authority of the WOAH Delegate of his/her country, to support the optimal collection and submission of aquatic animal disease information to the WOAH through WAHIS (immediate notifications and follow-up reports, six-monthly reports, and annual questionnaires) to enable the WOAH Delegate to more efficiently manage his/her WOAH Member obligations;
- 4. to act as a contact point with the WOAH Animal Health Information Department on matters related to information on aquatic animals including aquatic animal diseases;
- 5. to receive from the WOAH Headquarters copies of the reports of the Aquatic Animal Health Standards Commission and other relevant reports, and conduct the in-country consultation process with recognised aquatic animal health experts on draft texts of standards proposed in those reports; and
- 6. to prepare comments for the Delegate on relevant meeting reports reflecting the scientific view and position of the individual WOAH Member and/or the region, including comments on the proposals for new or revised WOAH standards related to aquatic animals.
