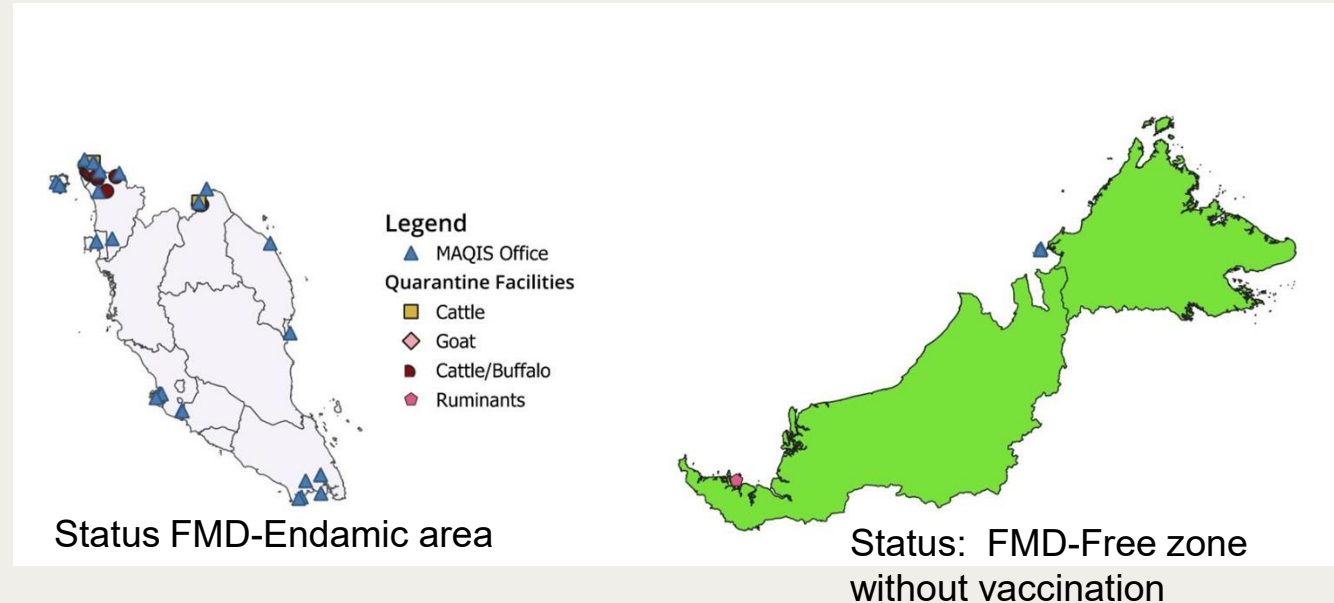

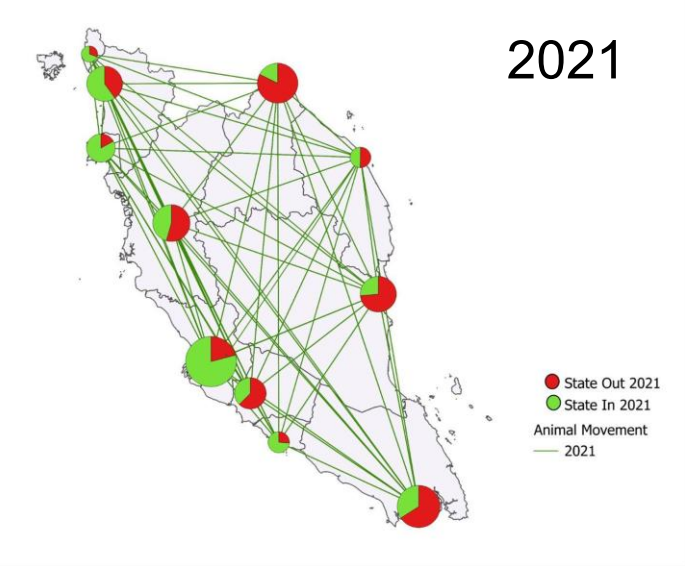

Quarantine facilities & cross border animal movement control

- **Different animal movement regulations apply in Malaysia:** Sabah & Sarawak (FMD-free zone without vaccination) vs. Peninsular Malaysia (FMD-endemic)
- **Border control** - Malaysia Border Control and Protection Agency, Ministry of Internal Affair
- **Importation and exportation** of livestock and livestock products - Malaysian Quarantine and Inspection Services.
- **DVS** is overseeing **movement** of livestock and livestock product **within the country**.
- **Inter agencies collaboration is crucial for an effective FMD and TADs control.**



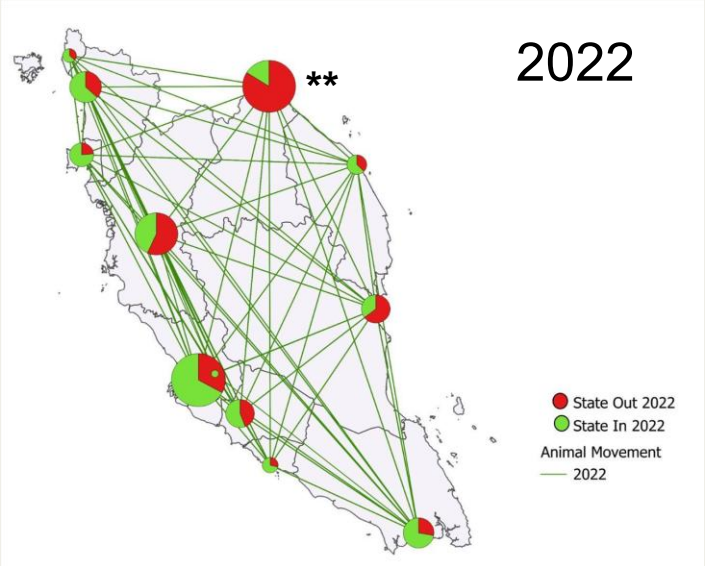
Animal movement within and estimated illegally moved animal into Peninsular Malaysia 2021– 2025

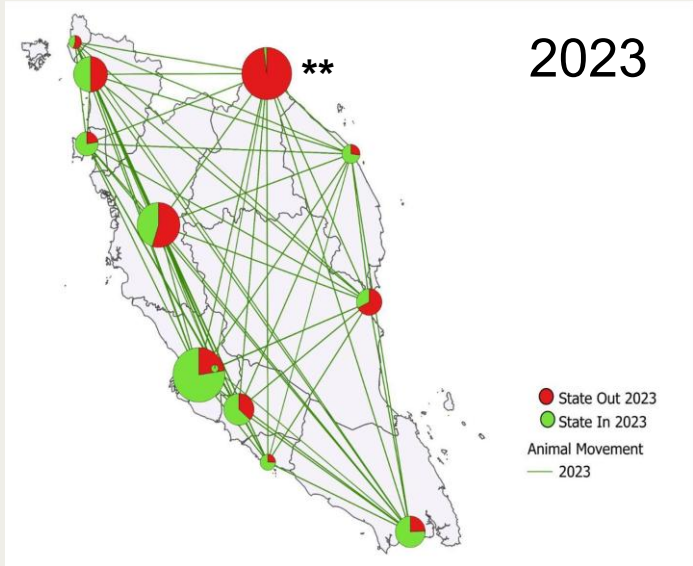

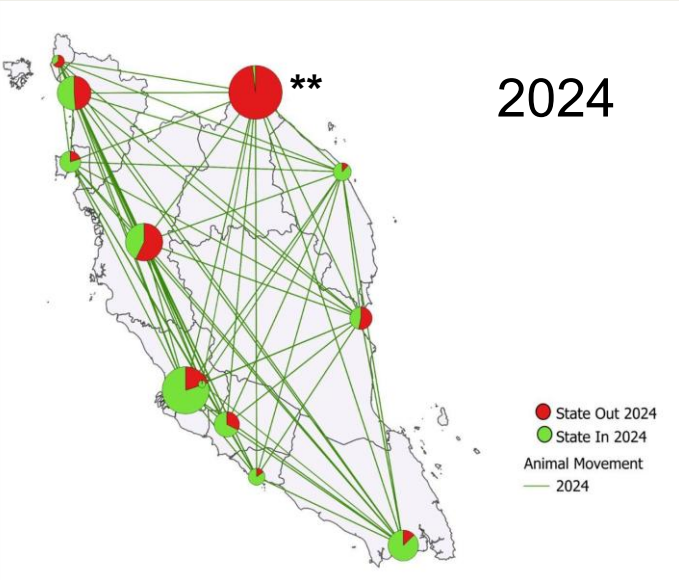
Illegal movement: small ruminant

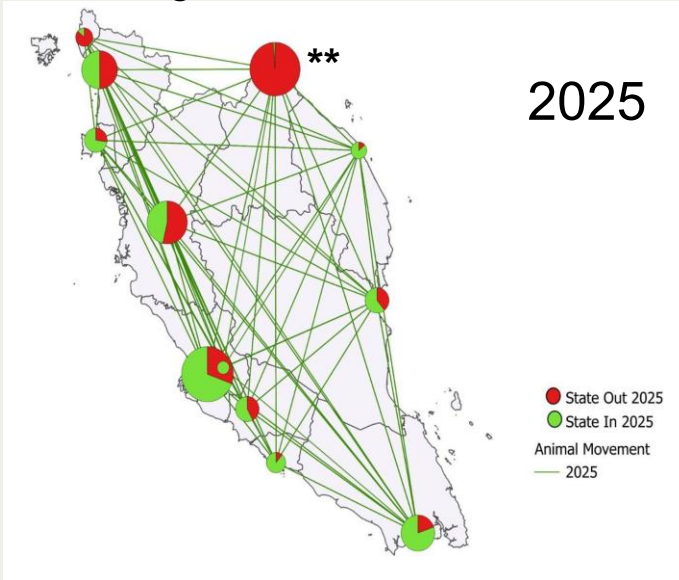
Illegal movement expand: small ruminant and buffalo

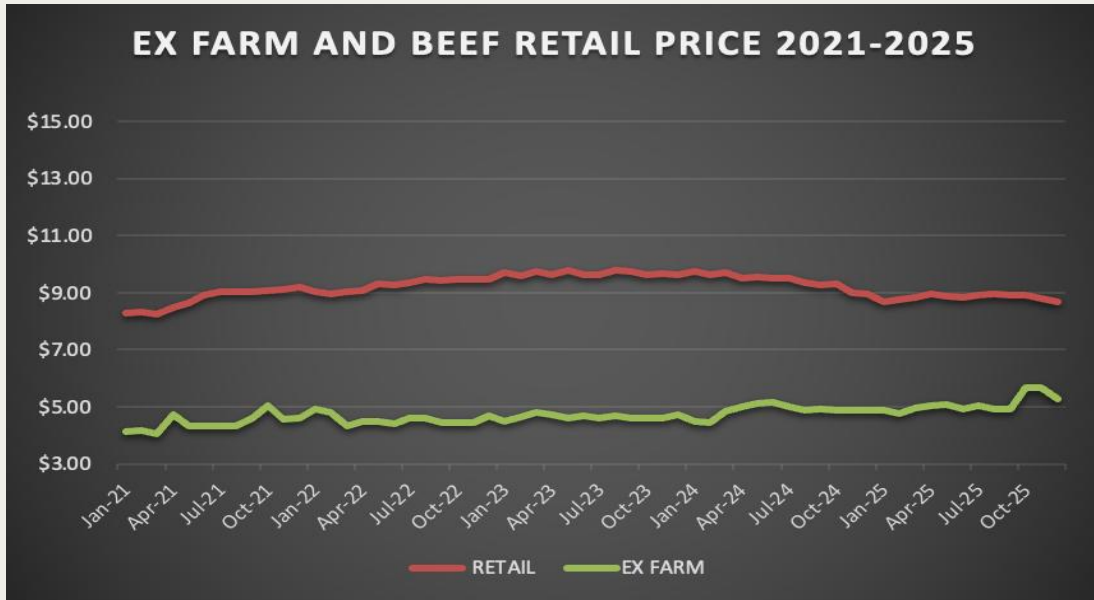

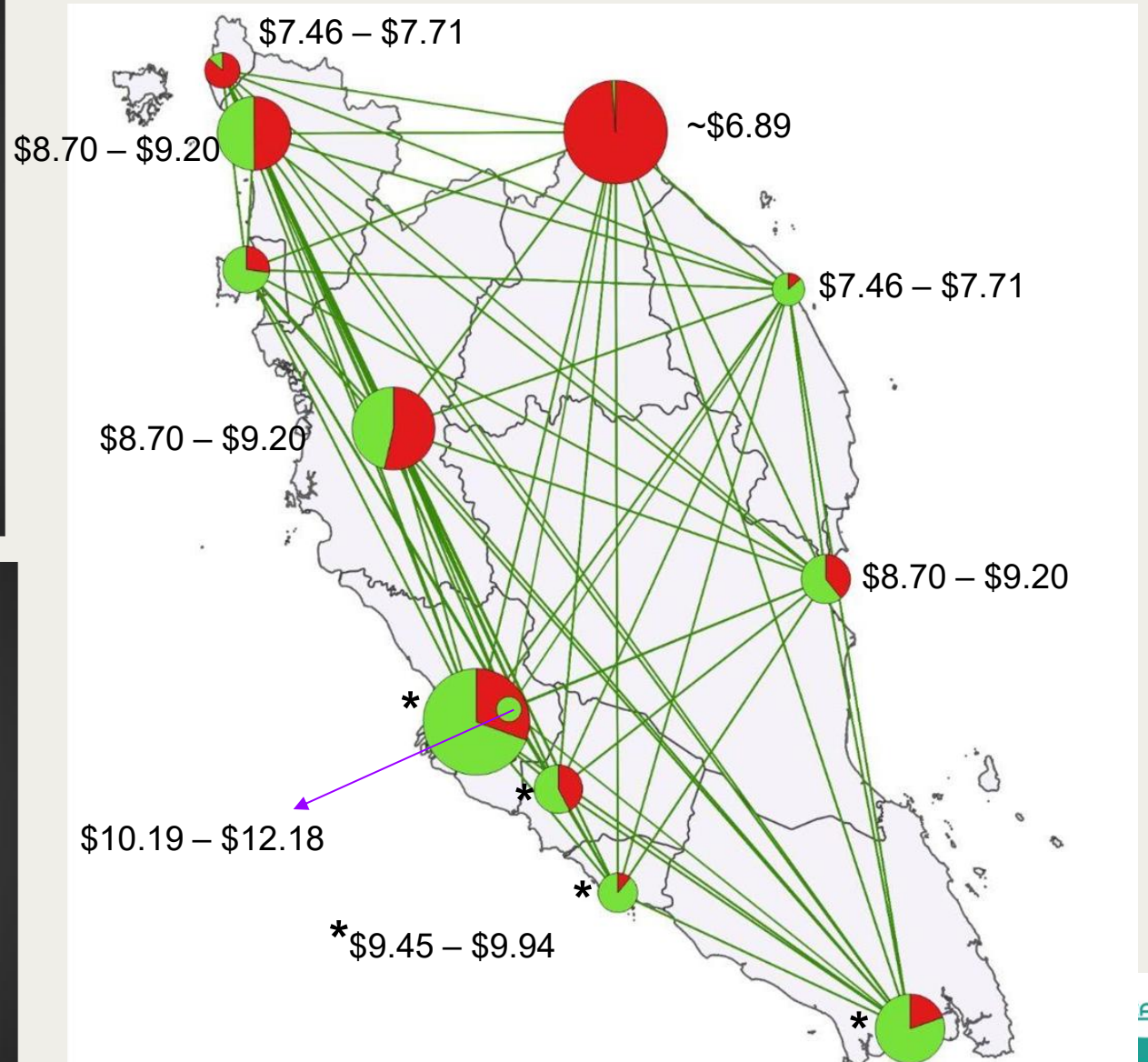

Average beef retail price in Peninsular Malaysia

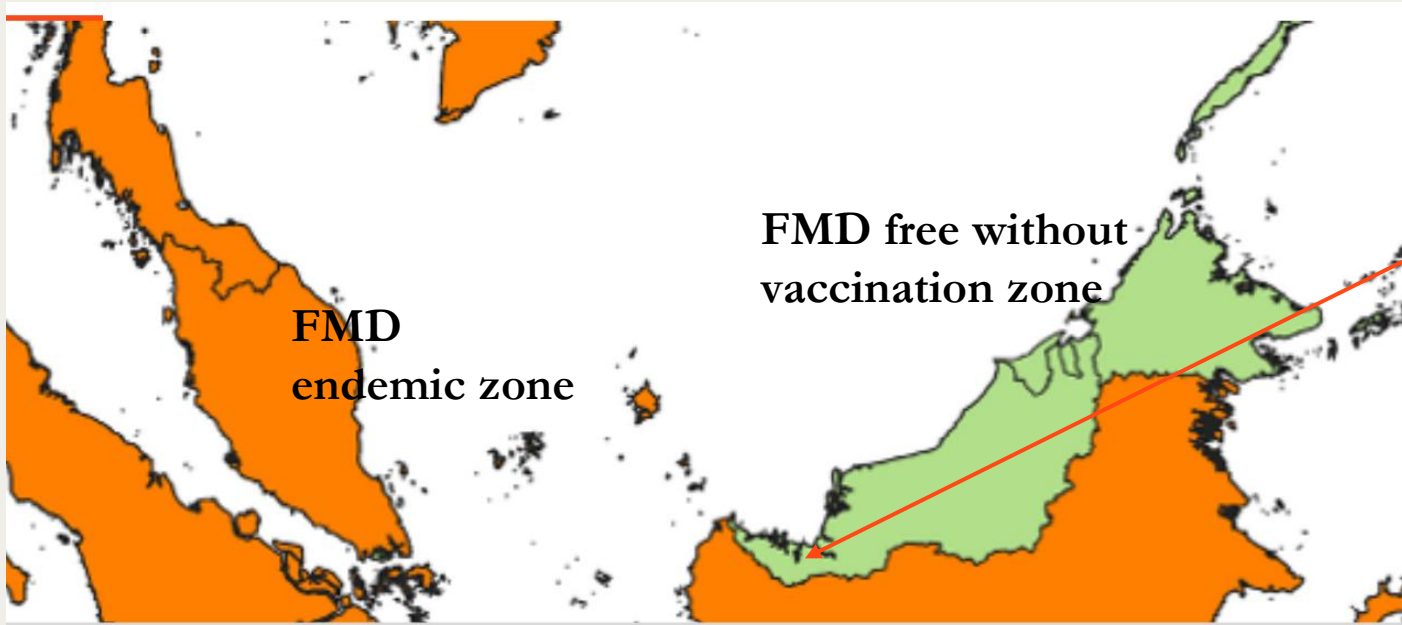


Average beef retail price influenced by urbanisation

Main Challenges in FMD-Endemic:

- Illegal animal movement disrupts development of FMD-free zones
- Weak compliance with vaccination schedules among ruminant traders and farmers



- ✓ FMD free compartment
- ✓ ASF free compartment
- ✓ Fully integrated (farm, feed mill, abattoir, retail outlet)
- ✓ Export live pigs to Singapore

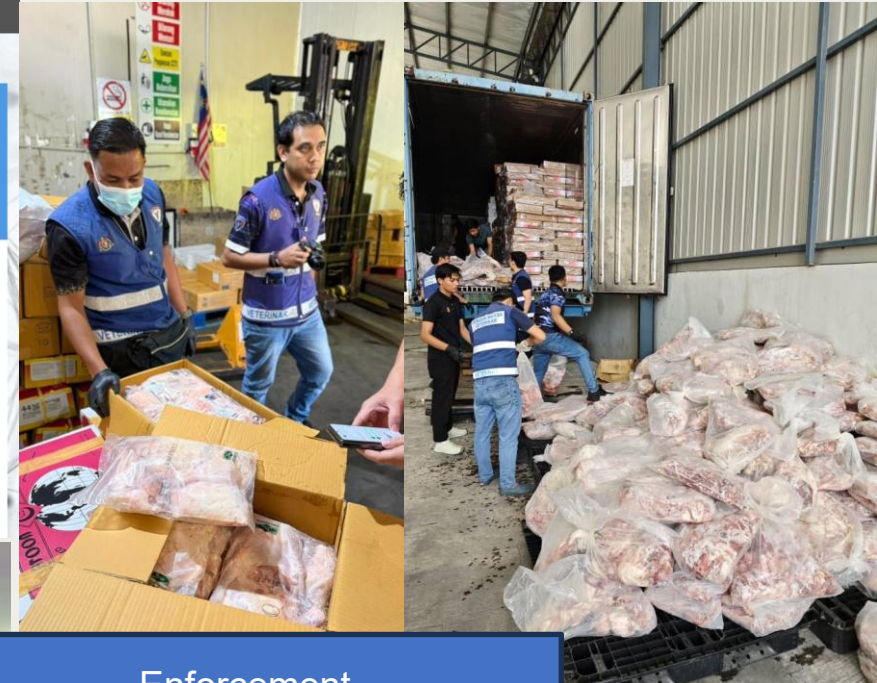

KOTA BHARU - Sultan of Kelantan, Sultan Muhammad V ordered that the proposal to build a wall and a sensing zone in the Golok River area should be finalized immediately.

"Beta takes security issues seriously on the Malaysia-Thailand border. So the proposal needs to be finalized immediately." His Majesty said while completing the Opening Ceremony of the 15th DUN Kelantan Third Stage in the Darulnaam City Complex here on today.

Also polluting duti, Sultanah Kelantan, Sultanah Nur Diana Petra Abdulah; Sinar Harian previously reported that the Kingdom of Kelantan needs RM445.748 million for the cost of taking back residential land in the Golok-River border area for the construction of walls and sembankment zones.

The Minister of Kelantan, Datuk Mohd Nasaruddin Mohd Daud said, the proposal for the construction of walls and span zones is very relevant for the purpose of national border security. He said, Kelantan is serious to combat smuggling crimes and overcome the flood problem in the Golok River area, which is 99 kilometers on the Malaysia-Thailand border.



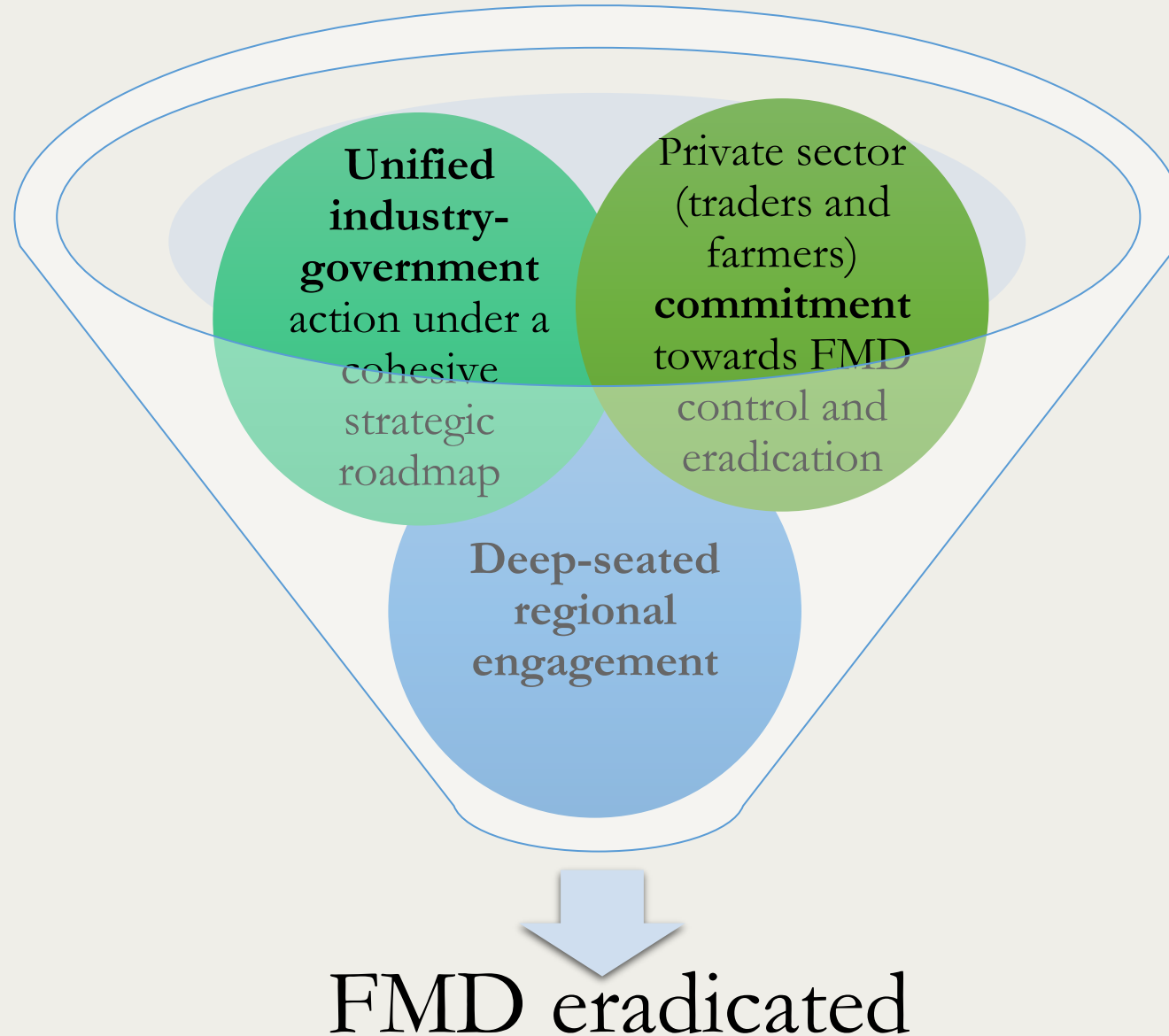
