Action points 15th Meeting of the Upper Mekong Working Group on Foot and Mouth Disease Zoning and Animal Movement Management, 24-26 April 2024 Luang Namtha, Lao PDR





Members	Please report what have been progressed since 2024 meeting
To organise regular technical meetings between local authorities from both sides of the bordering area	There are annual technical meetings with Lao authorities, including both animal health and border control, to conduct simulation exercises on HPAI and other relevant diseases and risks.
Conduct training on risk-based surveillance, outbreak investigation, laboratory diagnosis and response at the border area	Thailand conducted a training course, “AG 3.3 Livestock Development and Food Safety,” in 2025 for officials from Myanmar’s Livestock Breeding and Veterinary Department, focusing on animal movement control, animal quarantine stations, and inspection.
To include the promotion of safe and high-quality vaccine usage as the topic in the agenda for the bilateral agreement and discussions at G2G (Government) level	-
Members encourage to use of WOAHA available tools to strengthen (PPP. Tools including PVS, PPP targeted support, PPP handbook), e-learning courses and database on PPP	In 2024, Thailand has PVS Evaluation Follow-up missions conducted by WOAHA experts and the final reports were distributed, outlining both improvements achieved and areas that still need improvement.

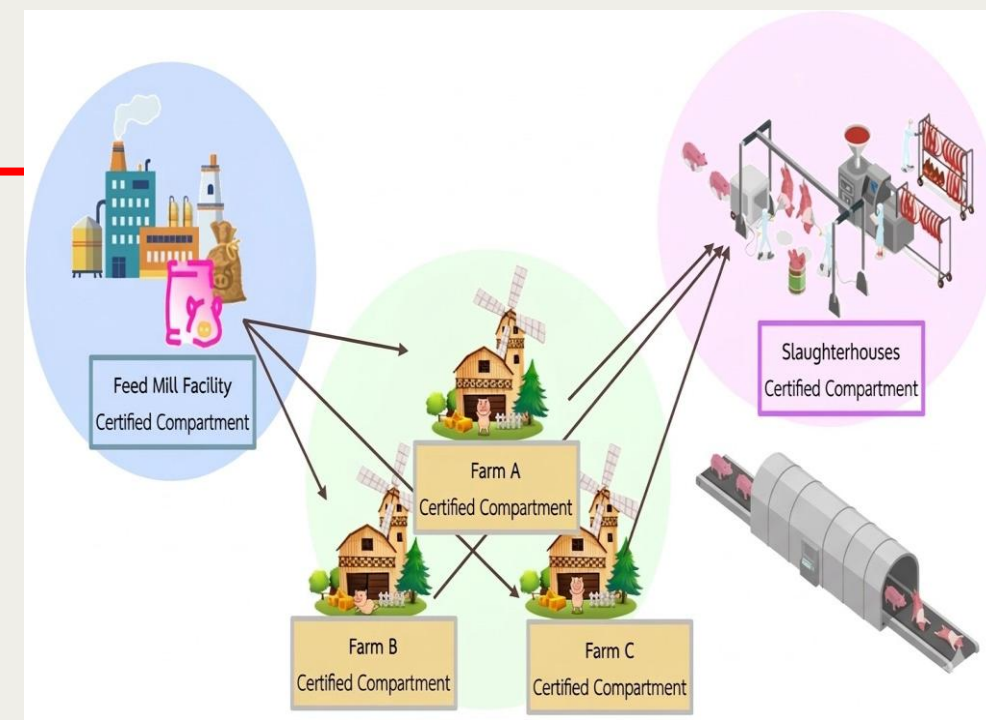
Bilateral agreement

to Vietnam



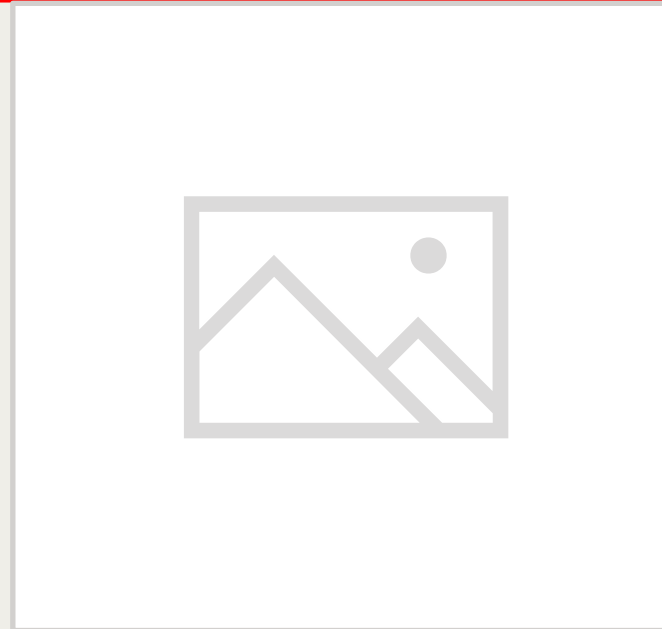
Zoning and Compartmentalisation

- There are 11 compartments that have been approved by DVS for exporting pork to Malaysia.
- Each compartment comprises of an approved slaughterhouse, farms and feed mill.
- There are 3 companies that have been approved: CP, Betagro, and VC Meat.



Capacity building

Division of Veterinary inspection and quarantine ,DLD regularly holds meetings with livestock traders and relevant agencies to understand the requirements for exporting live animals and products to other countries.



Workshop on the new e movement system is also provided for officials and traders.



Key messages

- WOAHA concepts can be used as a framework for the safe trade of live animals and animal products.
- Safe trade requires strong public–private sector collaboration.
- Studying regional animal movement patterns provides key information for preparedness planning and control measures.
