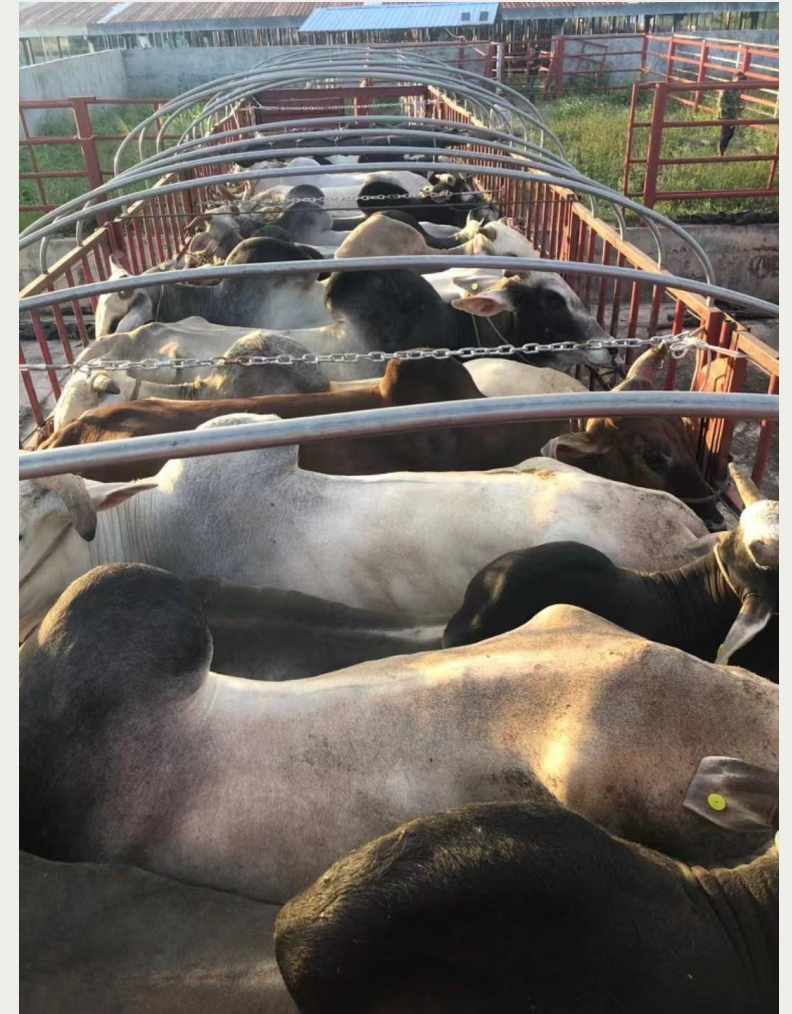
Introduction

Significantly, these companies are engaged in cattle breeding, trading, slaughtering and other related businesses.

In order to ensure the health of animals and prevent the cross-regional spread of animal diseases, we have established a strict animal disease monitoring system.

Including:

1. Purchasing live cattle only from the designated centralized breeding areas, and the cattle should be raised in the centralized breeding area for no less than 45 days.
2. Observing the clinical symptoms of diseases before the cattle are raised and disease monitoring. A Quarantine facility must be set up, and the quarantine period should be no less than 30 days. Affected animals should be promptly disposed of in a harmless manner to ensure there are no animal diseases.
3. At the same time, we take blood samples from cattle and send them to Vientiane for testing.



Current Situation

- Briefly describe current market or business or trade situation, market access

1. At present, China and Laos have established a mechanism for managing cattle trade, and cattle at the border can be traded normally.
2. We and the companies from Myanmar have not yet implemented cattle trade.
3. At present, cattle from Myanmar and other countries enter China via Laos, which has increased the trade costs.

Future trends

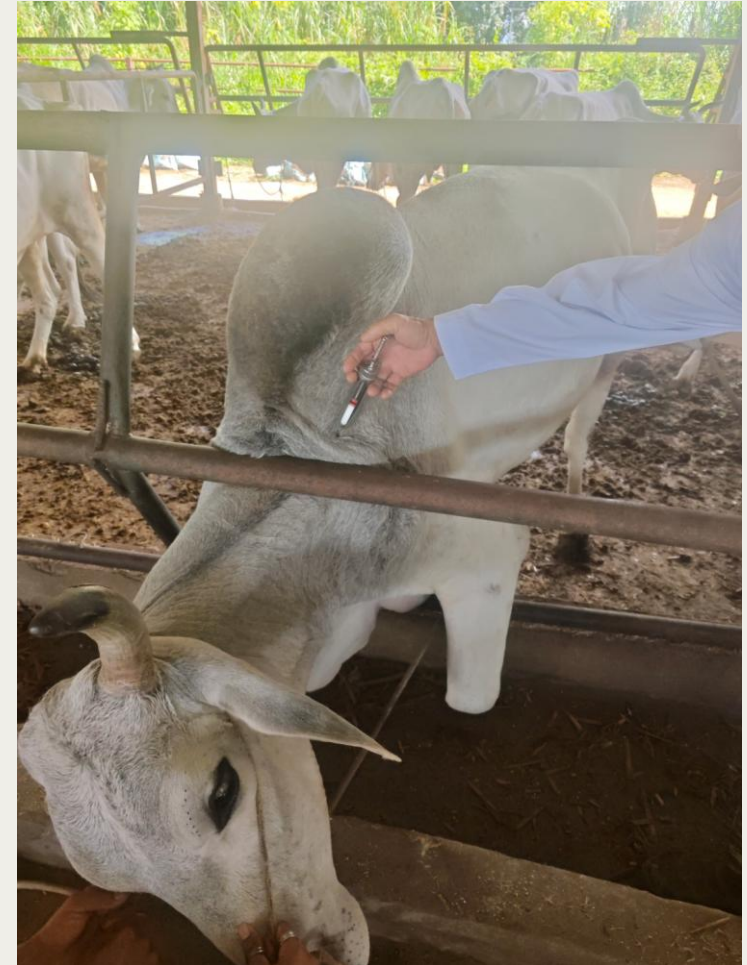
1. As China's domestic demand for beef continues to increase and beef prices continue to rise, we estimate that more cattle from Southeast Asian countries will enter China..
2. In the future, the trade of live cattle will decrease, while the trade of beef and its products will increase.

Experience sharing

1. We have established good cooperative relationships with the national and local animal disease prevention and control institutions of Laos, and have fully cooperated with the quarantine process to ensure that the cattle meet the quarantine standards.
2. Fully implement China's animal disease quarantine requirements to ensure that no cattle carrying foot-and-mouth disease virus or other major animal diseases enter the country.
3. It has played a significant role in the prevention and control of important animal diseases such as foot-and-mouth disease, ensuring the prevention of cross-border transmission of such important animal diseases.
4. At the same time, we attach great importance to animal welfare work. During the trade and slaughtering processes, we fully consider the welfare factors of the animals to ensure their comfort throughout the entire process.

Experience sharing

- **Vaccination strategies** : Cattle are required to be vaccinated against FMD at least once in the centralized feeding area and once more in the quarantine area.
- **Biosecurity** :Strictly prohibit outsiders from entering the livestock farm. Staff members within the farm must undergo strict disinfection and short-term isolation before they can enter the farm. All tools and facilities are disinfected regularly.
- **Quarantine** :Quarantine for at least 30 days
- **Transportation of animals** :Specialized animal transport vehicles are used to carry out the transportation along the designated routes, and strict disinfection is carried out before and after each transportation.
- **Working with farmers** :Establish a good cooperative relationship with farmers and provide them with regular guidance on breeding and vaccination.
- **Animal production (fattening etc)** :Based on the local plant resources, formulate a scientific feed formula to enhance the feeding efficiency.
- **Animal health and welfare** :The whole chain ensures the comfort of the cattle



Key challenges

Key challenges in relation to safe trade, business continuity and FMD control in your country, or Upper Mekong region, Policies, regulations, enforcements, market access or demand etc.

The costs in the cattle trade, including tariffs and quarantine fees, are relatively high.

The time it takes to provide samples and obtain test results is too long.

The overall profit is low.

Opportunities and Recommendations

1. It is suggested to enhance the overall national level of animal disease prevention and control technology.
2. Improve the efficiency of animal disease quarantine.
3. Increase the vaccination rate. Strengthen training and publicity efforts to enhance the ability and awareness of preventing and controlling animal diseases.
