- FAO and the World FOOD Forum (WFF) Innovation Labs Transformative Research Challenge (TRC) through the PPR Special Prize encourages young researchers to develop innovative research ideas that provide sustainable solutions for PPR control and eradication.
- This year's (2025) challenge is more gender-sensitive, prioritising the inclusion of diverse gender perspectives and addressing the specific needs of all genders in the process.
- Since 2022 with support from the European Commission, Flexible Voluntary Contribution (FVC) and FAO, the PPR Special Prize has been awarded (USD 8-10K) to support a total of 26 innovative research on PPR from various parts of the globe.

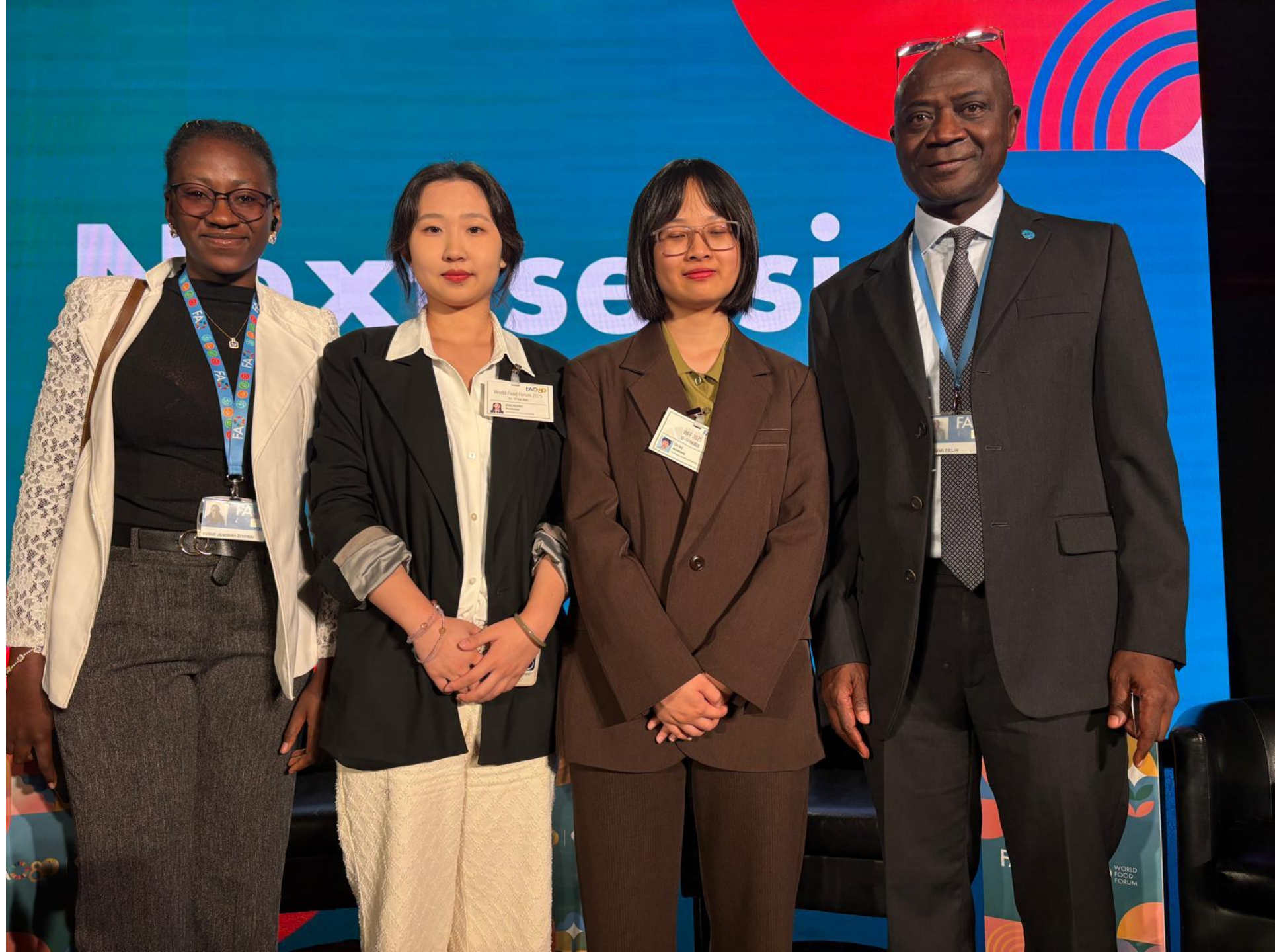
