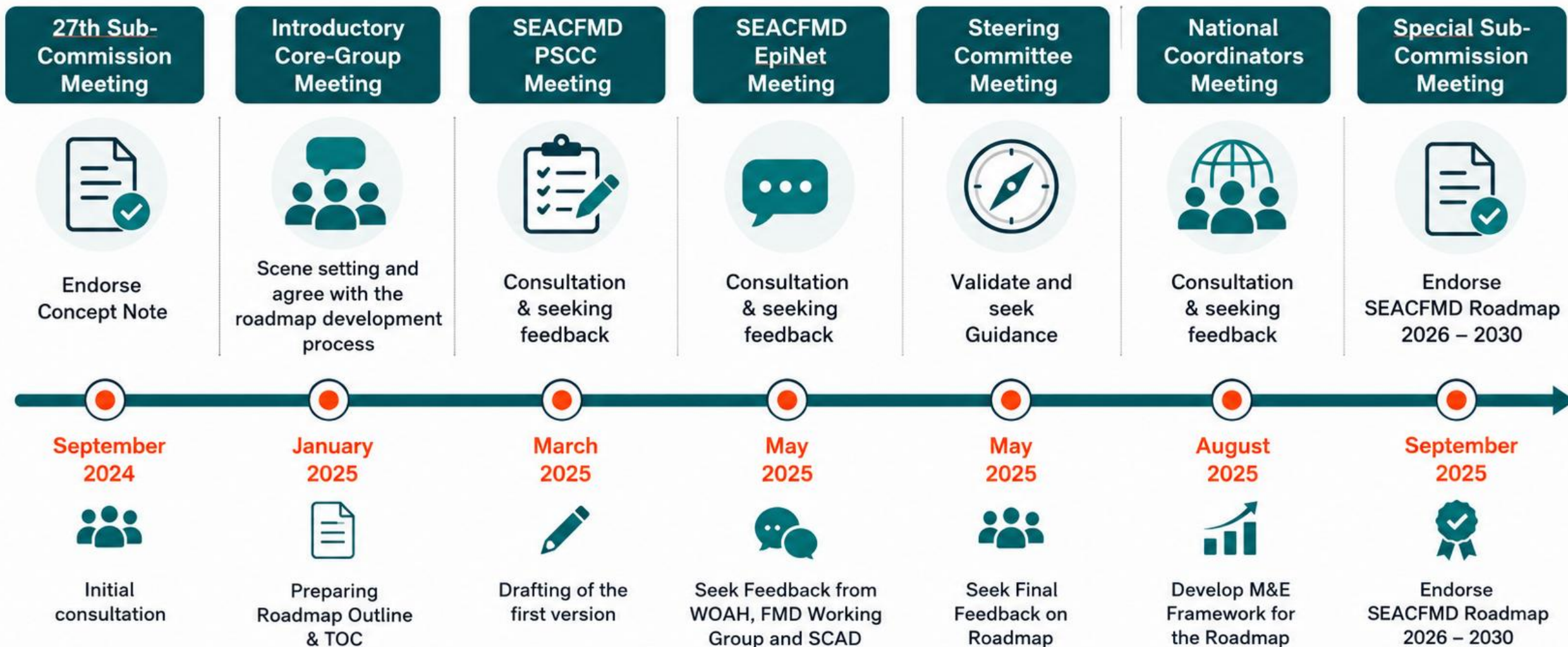

SEACFMD Roadmap Development



Objectives of the 28th SEACFMD Sub-Commission Meeting

- **Review** global and regional FMD situation and risks, including the spread of FMD serotype SAT1 to new areas, and to discuss key technical and operational challenges;
- **Review** progress, achievements, and challenges of the SEACFMD Campaign, and identify priority actions for implementing the **SEACFMD Roadmap 2026–2030**.
- **Provide updates** on the development of Global FMD Control Strategy and seek input to strengthen its alignment with the **SEACFMD Roadmap 2026–2030**.
- **Assess** the implications of the emergence of FMD serotype SAT1 and other emerging serotype risks, including SAT2, and discuss preparedness, surveillance, vaccine availability, and response measures.
- **Elect** President, Vice-Presidents and Steering Committee Members for the SEACFMD Sub Commission amongst the WOAHA Delegates.

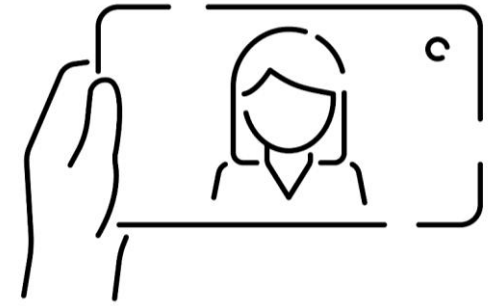

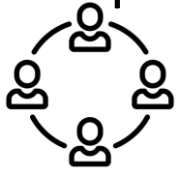
