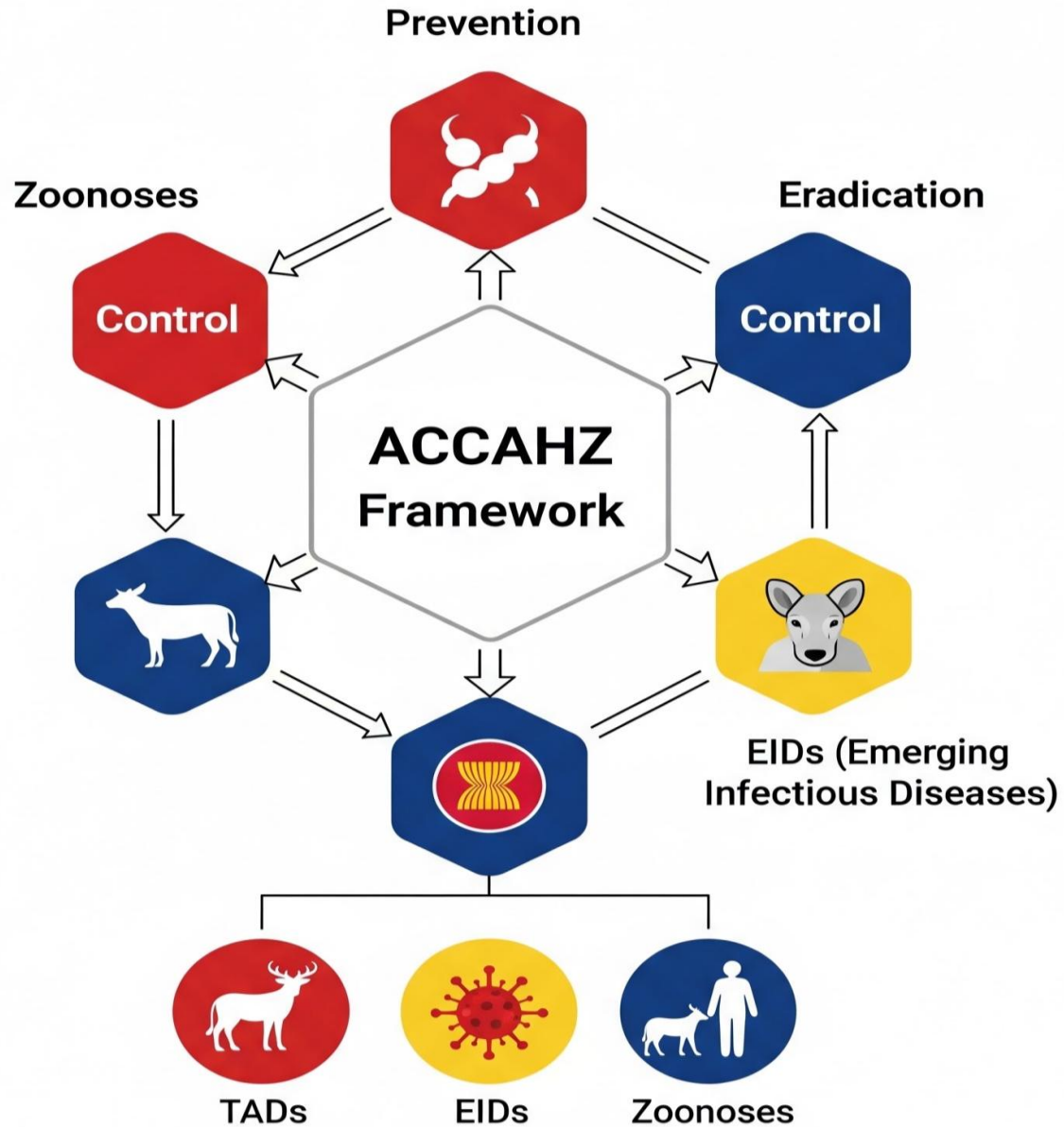
Mandate:

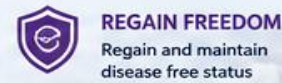

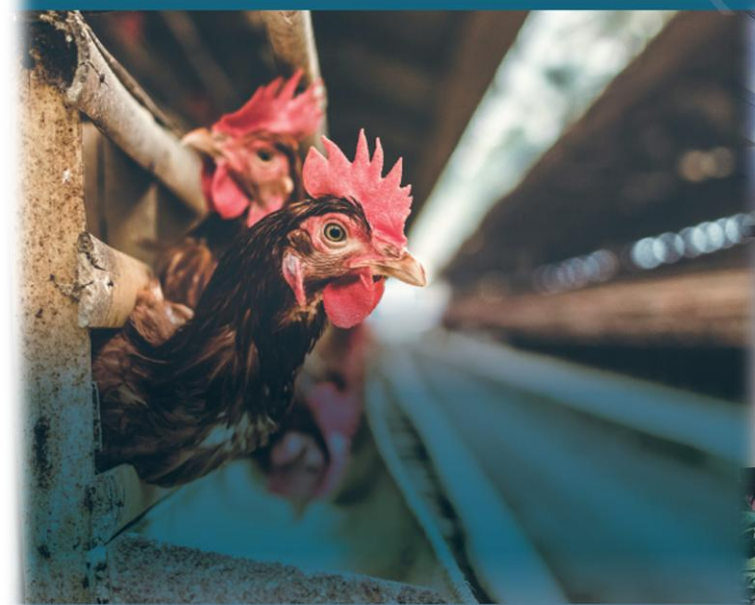

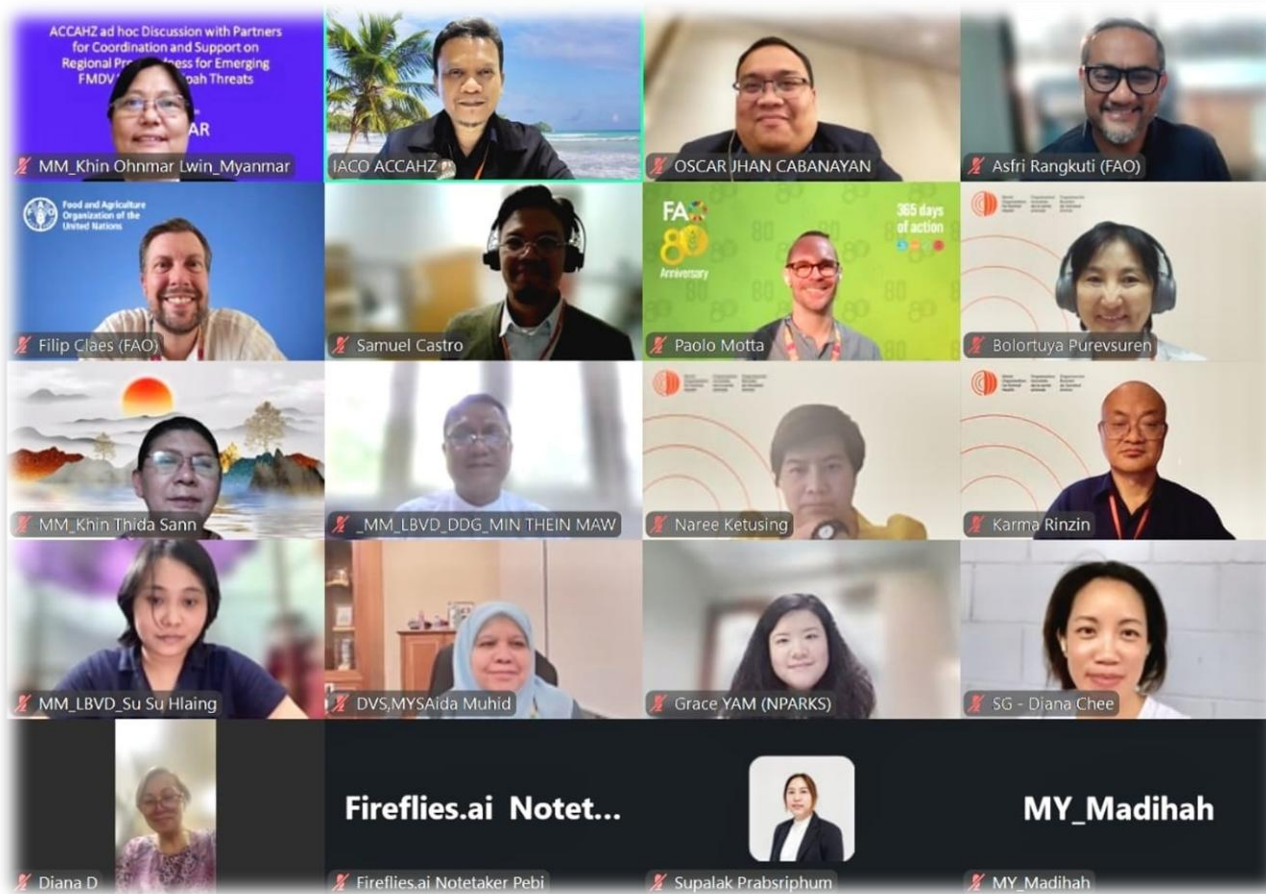
