



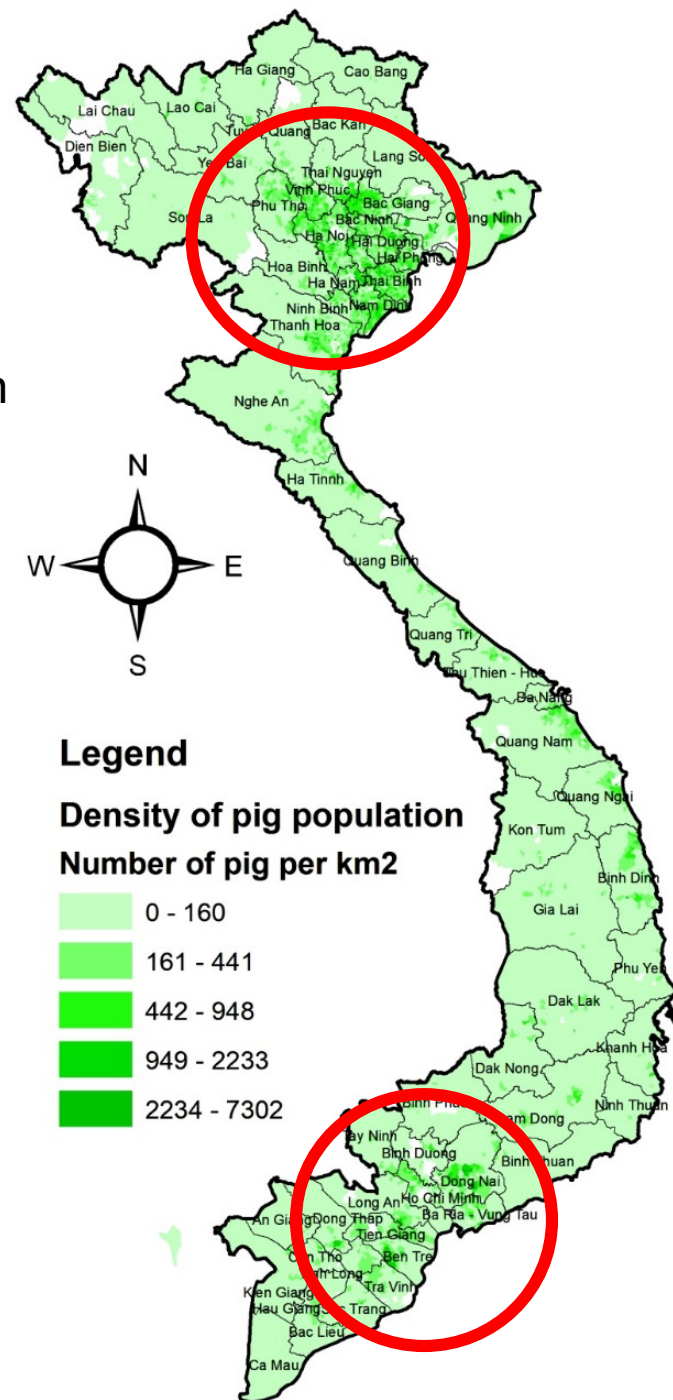

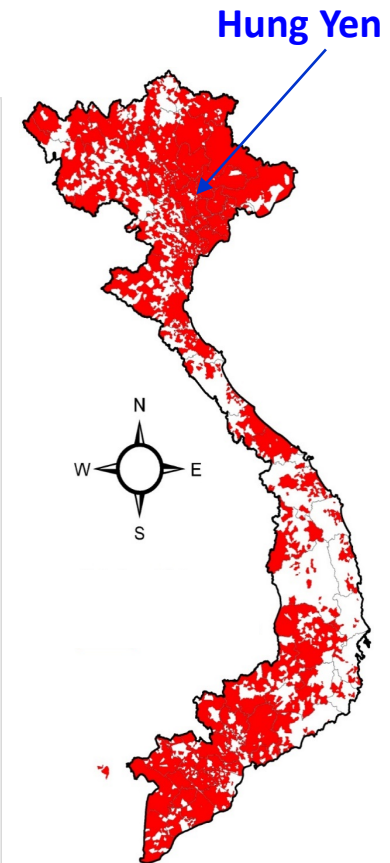
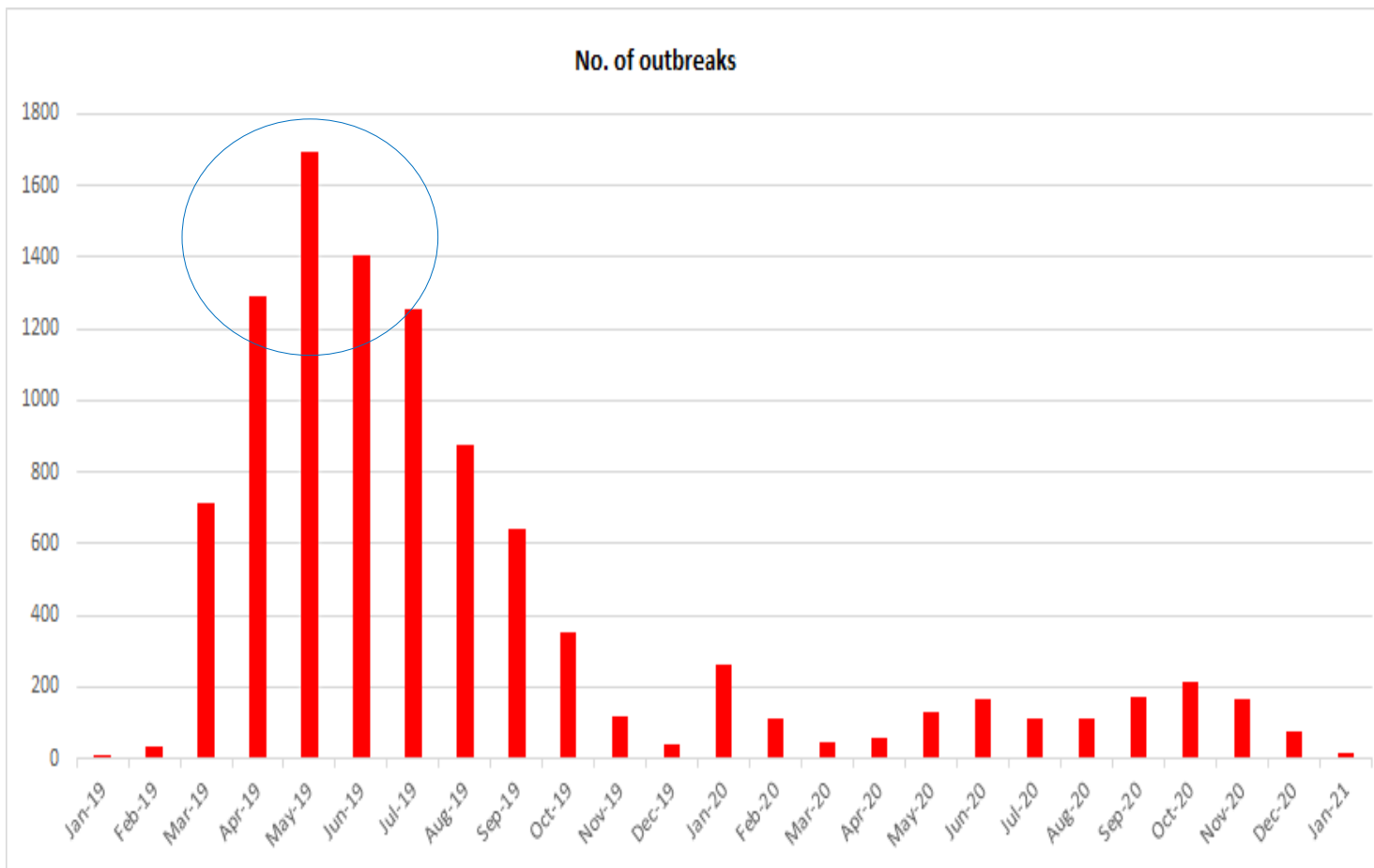
# Pig production

- **Pig population:**
  - Before ASF introduction (Dec 2018): > 31 million heads
  - As of 30 October 2020: ~ 26 million heads
- **Pig production:**
  - In 2018: 3.8 million tons (live weight)
  - In 2019: 3.3 million tons
- ASF as mainly affected small-scale production
- Re-stock: Changes to the different pig production systems (large scale, application of biosecurity)



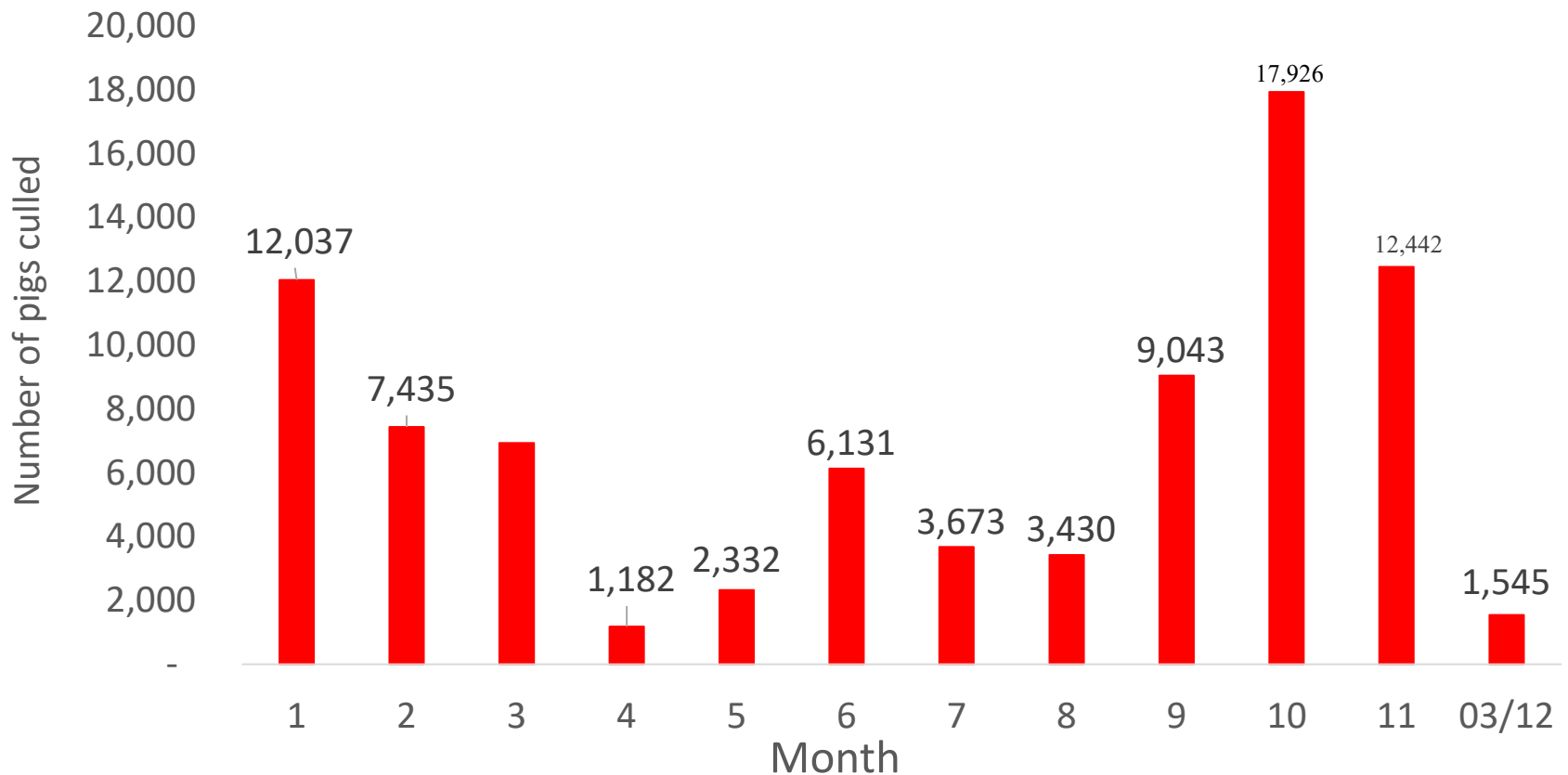
# ASF situation

- First detection of ASF on **01 Feb 2019** in Hung Yen province (in the North)
- By Dec 2019, more than **8,500** infected communes in **63/63** provinces; **6 mil** pigs culled



# ASF situation

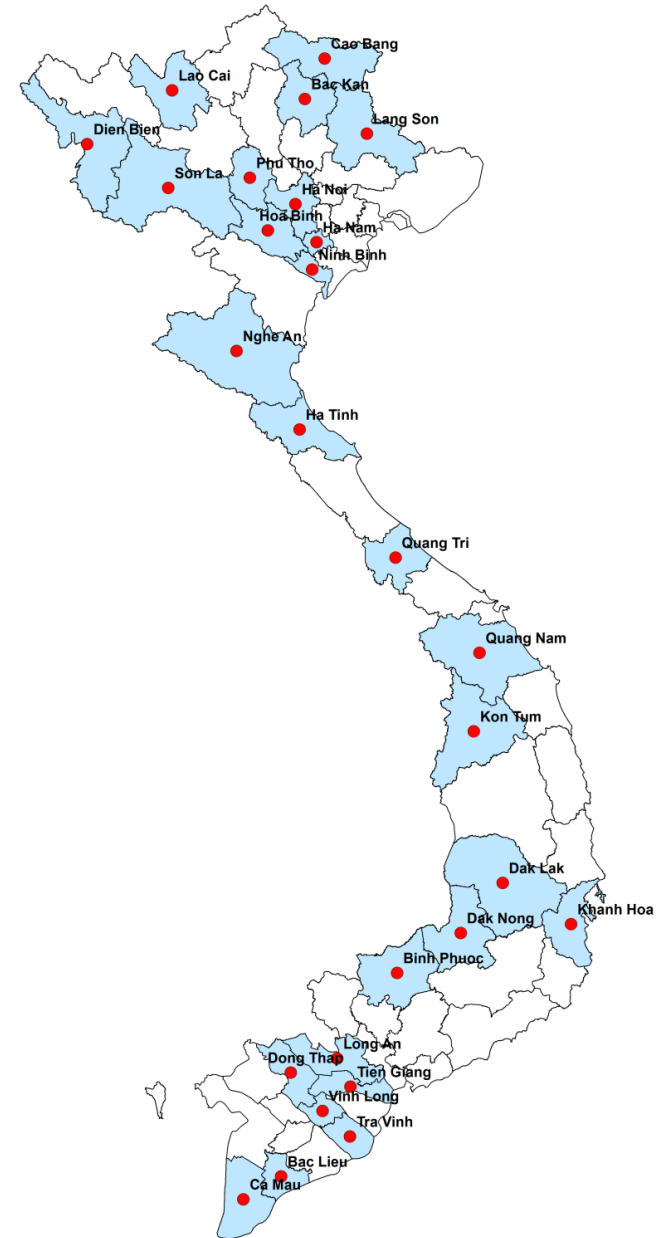
- By Dec 2020: 1,632 outbreaks were reported in 50 provinces
- 87,000 pigs were culled, ~ 4,390 tons



# Current ASF status

As 4 Feb 2021:

- 132 outbreaks being reported in 30 provinces
- 6,319 pigs culled cumulatively



# Policies relating to ASF

- “National Plan for Prevention and Control of African Swine Fever, for the period 2020-2025” approved by **Prime Minister** on 07 June 2020 (Decision No. 972/QĐ-TTg)
- **Overall goal:** To pro-actively monitor for early detection, warning, and timely; effective control and prevention of ASF

## DECISION

**Approve of the “National Plan for Prevention and Control of African Swine Fever, for the period 2020-2025”**

PRIME MINISTER

Pursuant to the Law on Government Organization dated June 19, 2015;

Pursuant to the Veterinary Law dated June 19, 2015;

Pursuant to the Animal Husbandry Law dated November 19, 2018;

Pursuant to the Resolution No. 11/NQ-CP dated February 14, 2020 of the January 2020 regular meeting of the Government;

At the request of the Minister of Agriculture and Rural Development made by the Proposal No. 3440/TTr-BNN-TY dated May 21, 2020.

## DECIDED:

**Article 1.** Issuing, in attachment to this Decision, the National Plan for Prevention and Control of African Swine Fever, for the period from 2020 to 2025 (hereafter referred to as “the Plan”).

**Article 2.** Funding for the Plan shall be allocated from the State budget and other sources as legally appropriate according to prevailing regulations.

**Article 3.** This Decision shall come into effect from the date of signing.

**Article 4.** Ministers of ministries which are members of the National Steering Committee for ASF, Standing Representative of the National Steering Committee for fighting against smuggling, commercial frauds and counterfeit goods, Chairpersons of provincial people’s committees and related organizations and individuals are liable to implement this Decision./.

# **NATIONAL PLAN FOR ASF 2020-2025**

1. Enhancing biosecurity in pig production
2. Precautions when restocking
3. Disease surveillance
4. Disposal of ASF infected or suspected pigs
5. Control of pig movement, trade of pigs and pig products
6. Management of pig slaughter and consumption of pig products
7. Cleaning and disinfection
8. Develop areas, farms and production chains free from diseases
9. Strengthening capacity for diagnosis and testing
10. Study of ASF epidemiological characteristics and ASF vaccine
11. Communication for awareness raising and behavioral change
12. International cooperation
13. Support policies

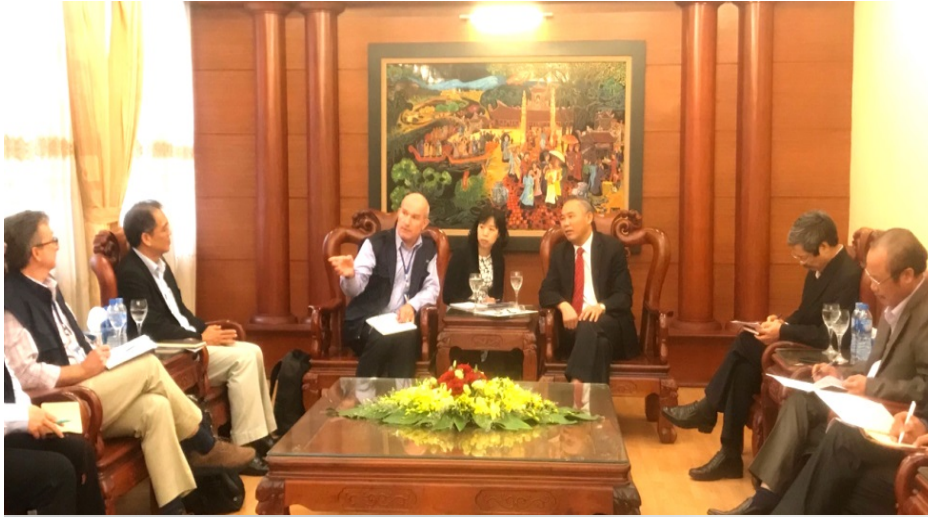




Prime Minister visited and lead control activities at infected areas
