## VEE accreditation in Thailand

- The Veterinary Profession Act, B.E. 2545 (2002)
- According to the Act, the Board of Veterinary Council of Thailand issued the <u>VCT Regulation on Accreditation of the DVM degree from</u> the <u>Veterinary Education Establishment</u>, <u>B.E. 2552 (2009)</u>
- Apply for the VCT membership and professional licensure
  - Did not require for the national examination until 2014
  - Has required for the national examination (MCQ at the end of the 5<sup>th</sup> year DVM study) since 2015







## VEE accreditation in Thailand

According to <u>VCT Regulation on Accreditation of the DVM degree</u>
 <u>from the Veterinary Education Establishment</u>, <u>B.E. 2552 (2009)</u>, the
 VCT has issued the VCT Announcement [No. 7/2552 (2009) B.E.]on
 the Standards for Curriculum Approval and Veterinary Faculty
 Certification.








## **VCT- VEE Accreditation Process**

#### **Step 1 - Curriculum**



#### Resolution of the Board for Curriculum

- Approved
- Approved with conditions, revised version must be submitted within a due course
- Disapproved (resubmit the revised curriculum could be done after 90 days from disapproved date)








## **VCT-VEE Accreditation Process**

#### **Step 2 - Institution**



#### **Resolution of the Board for Institution**

- Certified
- Certified with conditions, improvement/re-correction must be submitted within a due course
- Uncertified (request for new evaluation could be done after 180 days from uncertified date )







## **VCT - VEE Accreditation Process**

**Step 1 - Curriculum Step 2 - Institution** 



- Accreditation period → 5 years (7 years)
- Request for the accreditation or the renewal must be submitted to the VCT at least 180 days before student admission







## The 10 standards for evaluation of curriculum and institution (VCT announcement 7/2552 B.E.)

- 1. University qualification
- 2. Instructors and supporting staff
- 3. Student admission system
- 4. Curriculum (courses in detail)
- 5. Pre-veterinary course management
- 6. Pre-clinical course management
- 7. Clinical course management
- 8. Infrastructures (Building, Laboratories, Animal Hospital, Diagnostic Laboratories, Demonstrating Farms, etc.)
- 9. Library and information technology system
- 10. Quality assurance in education (institutional level)

### Revision of the VCT standards in VEE accreditation


- > The AVBC accreditation standards are used as reference.
