

# Zero by 30 and the Global Strategic Plan




Countries need to lead their own rabies elimination efforts, which can be supported of the Global Community.

# The Stepwise Approach towards Rabies Elimination (SARE)





**Self-assessment that provides practical guidance** on how to implement rabies control activities

- Supports the One Health concept





**Estimated cost to eliminate dog mediated rabies by dog vaccination**




# Workplans that support National Strategies




**The national workplan is the executable form of the National Strategic plans**
