- ❖ In Cambodia: Since late March 2019 (around 5000 died and culled)
 - Rottanakikiri: Declared on 2 April 2019
 - Tbong Khmom: 02 July 2019
 - Svayrieng: 8 July 2019
 - Takeo: 8 July 2019
 - Kandal: 12 July 2019

- ✓ Letter no. 11560 MAF, 04 Dec 2018 for concerned Ministry to control the illegal import of pig and pig products
- ✓ Directive No. 119 MAFF, 21 Feb 2019, on the urgent measures to monitor and control of ASF
- ✓ Directive No. 232 MAFF, 30 May 2019, on the urgent measures to monitor and control of ASF
- ✓ MAFF Declarations of outbreak areas: Rattanakiri, Tbong Khmom, Svay Rieng, Takeo, Kandal.
- ✓ Selective culling, disinfection, and quarantine
- ✓ Awareness Raising with stakeholders about ASF.
