



Prof. Md. Ahasanul Hoque is Professor of Veterinary Epidemiology, Department of Medicine and Surgery, Faculty of Veterinary Medicine (FVM), Chattogram (previously Chittagong) Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, Bangladesh. He served as Dean, FVM (Feb 2015-2017) and Coordinator of Advanced Studies and Research (Mar 2013-2015).

Dr. Hoque has experience of leading multinational collaborative projects. Dr. Hoque is the National Coordinator of the GCRF One Health Poultry Hub(BB/S011269/1) which also involves Chatham House and the Royal Veterinary College. He has also acted as National Coordinator for other BBSRC-funded projects on zoonoses in poultry farming (**BB/L018993/1**) and **has led or co-led other international research and educational projects** funded by Sweden, FAO, DFID and DANIDA, World Bank and EU, and OIE-for **OIE Veterinary Education Twinning Project**. It is noteworthy to mention that Dr. Hoque completed his MSc in Vet Epidemiology from RVC (UK) and PhD from JCU (AUS) and has persistent connections with these countries for research and education.
