Recap of goals and timeline for revision of ASEAN rabies elimination strategy

1. Update existing ARES to reflect recent national and regional progress and development of tools to support rabies control and elimination
2. Align with *Zero by 30: Global Strategic Plan to end human deaths from dog-mediated rabies by 2030*
3. Adapt to specific contexts and on-the-ground realities in ASEAN Member States
